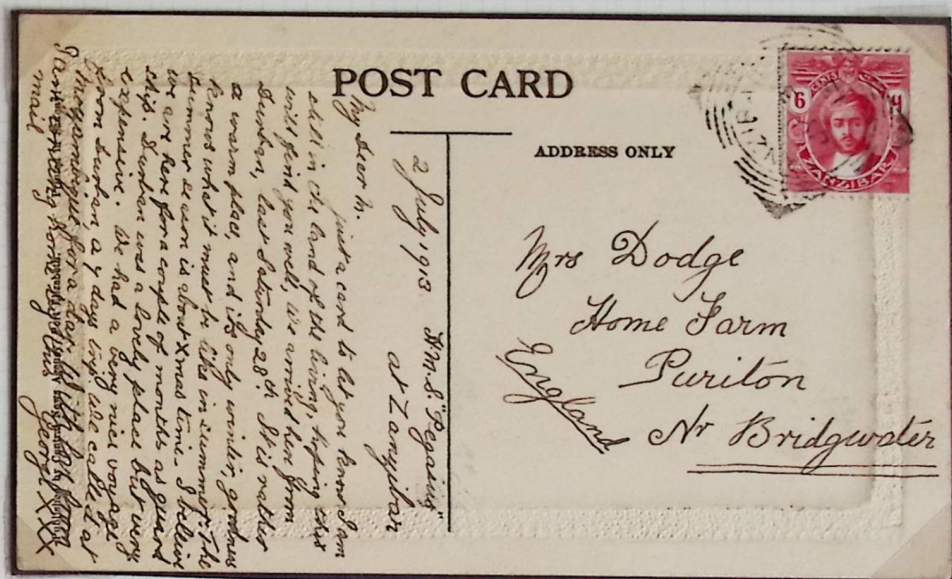

July 1913 card from Mrs. Pegasus, based at Zanzibar, to Devon
(Pegasus was attacked and put out of action by the German cruiser
Koenigsberg in September 1914, while at Zanzibar)



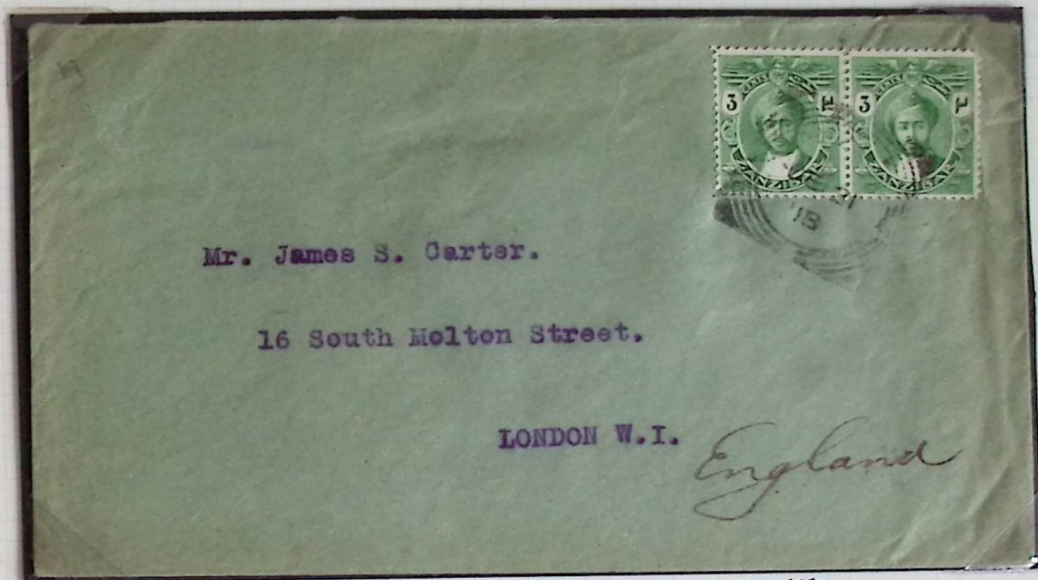
October 1914 Card to Southampton (via Mombasa)
- safely received despite German naval action!

31 December 1915 single rate cover to the UK.



10 January 1916 double rate registered (15c + 12c) cover to California.
Arrival stamp of 4 March. The two higher values are wmk Rosettes

11 April 1922 card to London, showing the short-lived 12c Empire rate

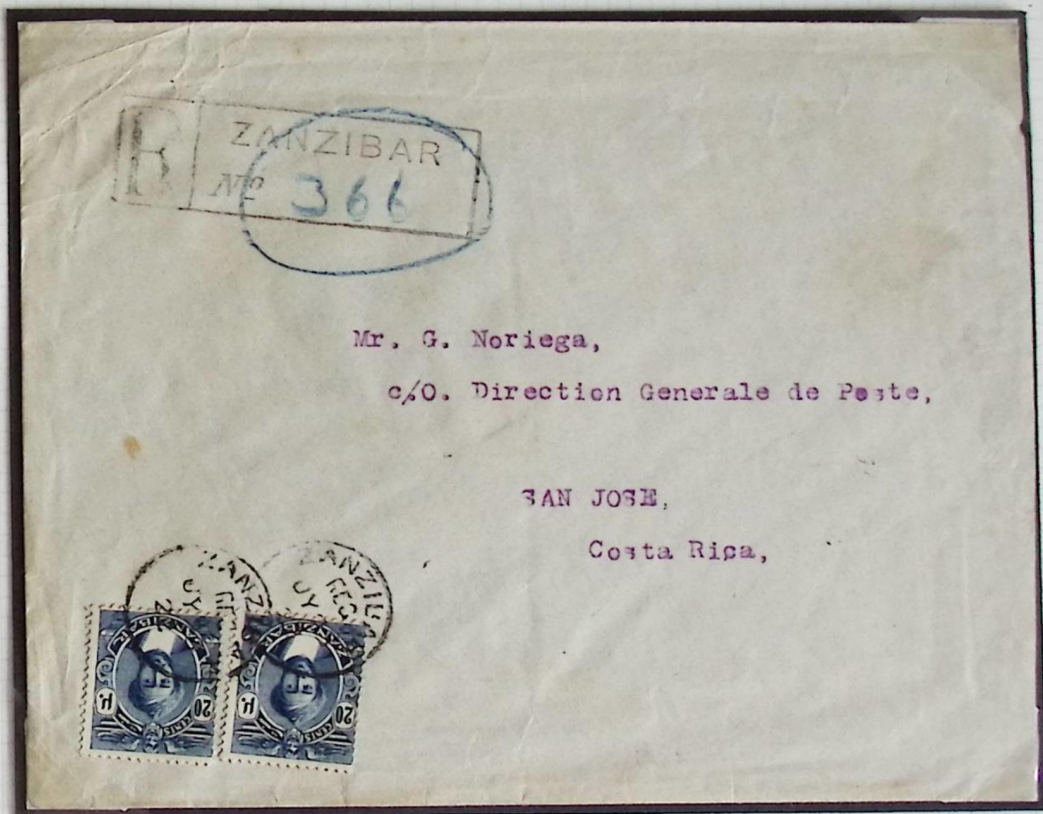


8 March 1925 cover to Dublin : reversion to 6cents rate

French mailship cancel : 24 July
Received San Jose : 8 Sept.

Marseille



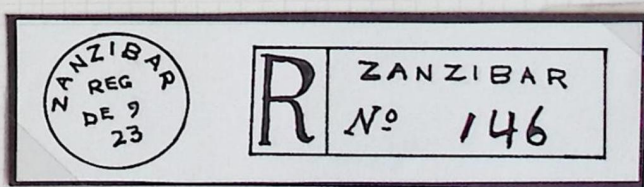

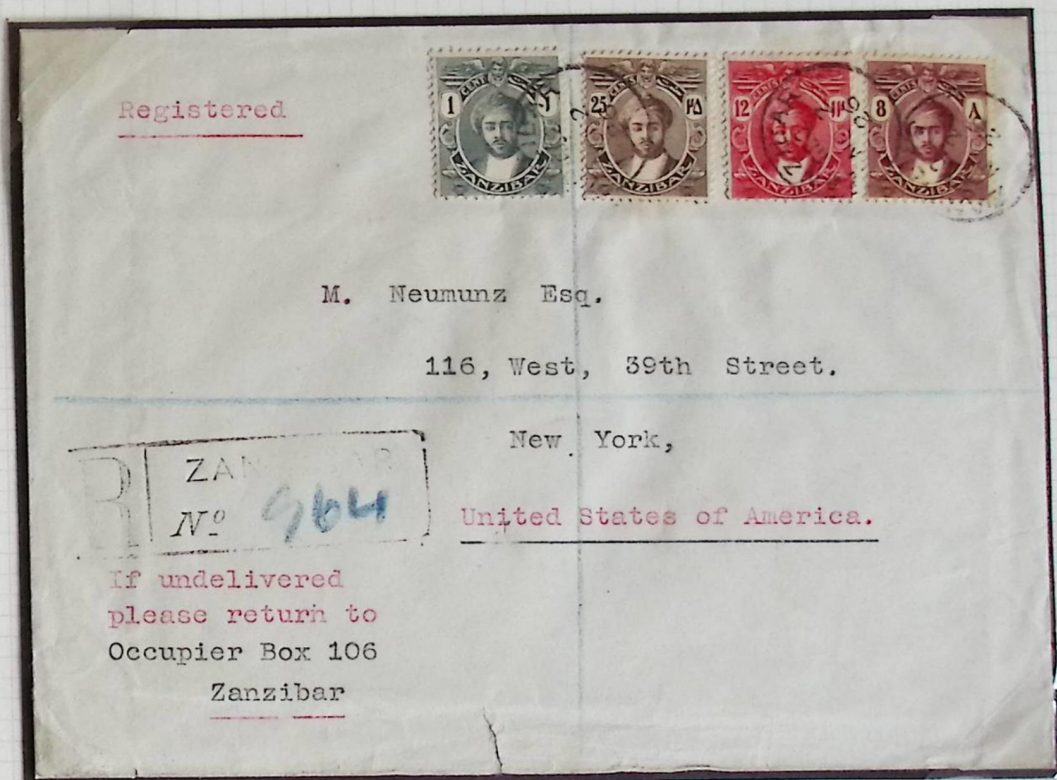
December 1923. Single registered rate (20c+20c) cover, at the non-Empire rate, to Berlin

New York : 7 December

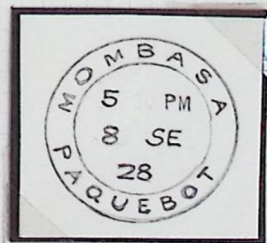

Mombasa Paquebot cancel



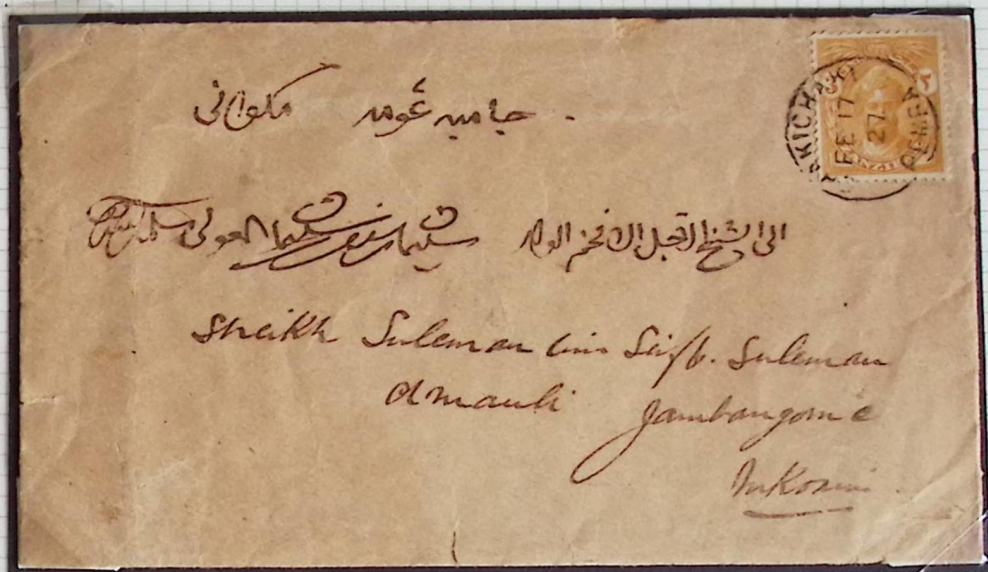

February 1927, local single-rate cover from Chakichaki to Mkoani (also on Pemba Island)

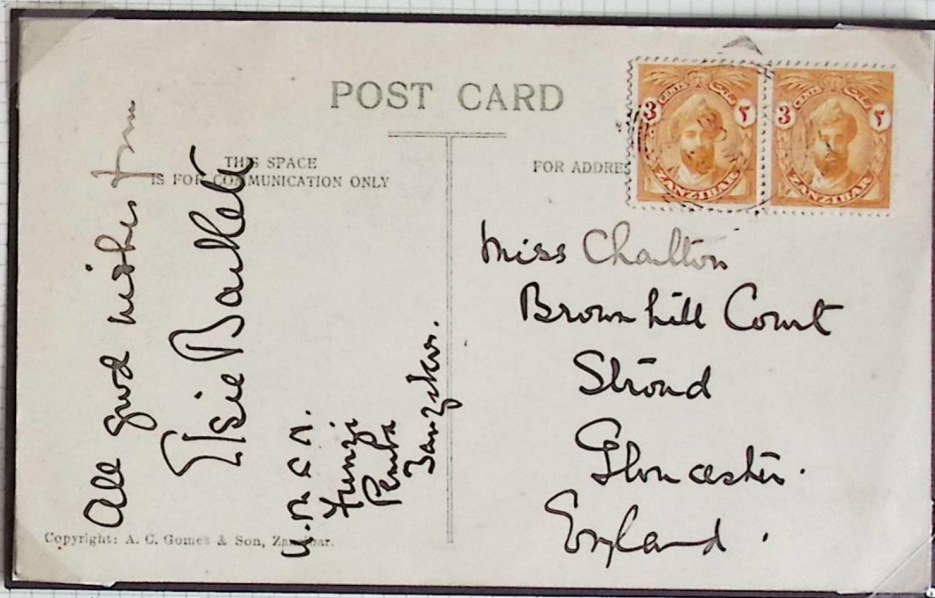

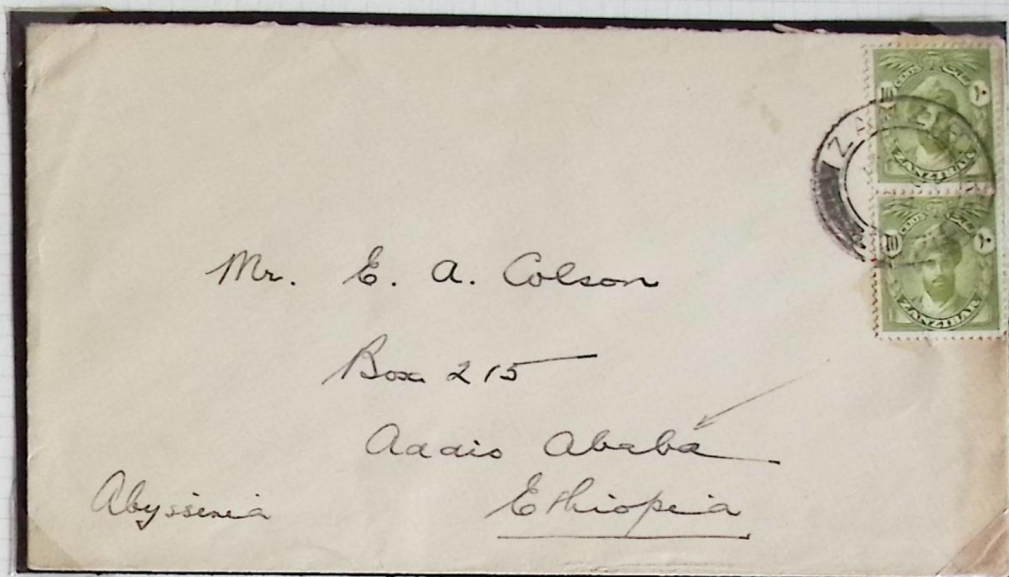

November 1934 Airmail cover from Wete (Pemba) to Mombasa. Backstamped Zanzibar. Franked 21c Airmail rate

1929 covers to UK showing 6 cents standard Empire postage rate.



Both envelopes stamped on reverse. Second cover stamped
26c (standard rate plus 20c registration)
