INDIAN TRIBES POSTCARDS

Argentina, (1905/1906): Tierra del Fuego indian (Onas and Yamanes) postcards: a small selection (14) including natives Photo-postcards and a "Liebig" collection (6) pastel beautiful coloured paintings of the different environments that were inhabited by local tribes.

The Onas or Selk'nam were hunters of "Guanacos" and used their pelt as a coat. The Yagans were coastal dwellers of the Beagle channel that lived from fishes and hunted for seals and small dolphins with their harpoons. The yagan "canoe" was their way of moving around the many islands of the Beagle channel islands. The "Yagans" or "Yamana" concentrated around the Beagle channel and the islands to the South. The "Alakaluf", the third tribe, ranged throughout the remote western islands as far north as Golfo de Penas.

Indios Ona, Haberton Tierra del Fuego

Onas Indians at (Puerto) Harberton, Beagle channel, Tierra del Fuego "Estancia Harberton" placed at 60 km by land from the capital Ushuaia, was the first western (British) settlement at Tierra del Fuego under the leadership of the Anglican priest Thomas Bridge. The estancia owners were in permanent contact with local tribes who were "educated" and evangelized in cooperation with the Falkland's settlers. This Rosauer print shows an Ona family living nearby Harberton. This pc original photo was used to illustrate the *Patagonia* book's cover shown in the front page of this small collection. (Not circulated). This pc is also known as a colour print.

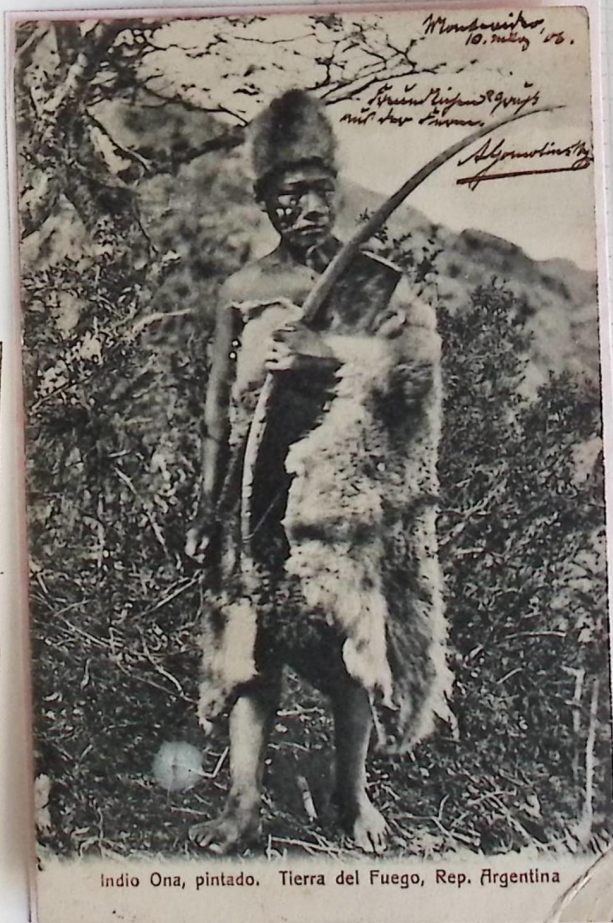

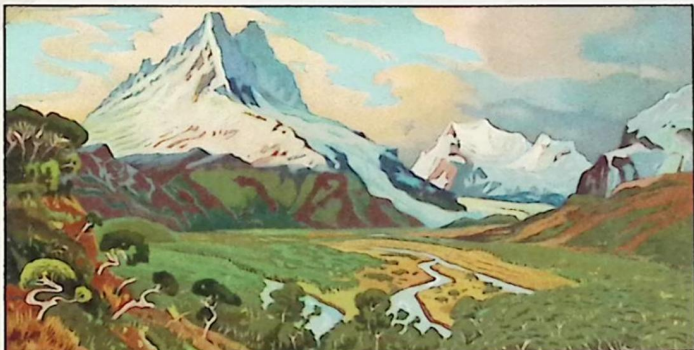

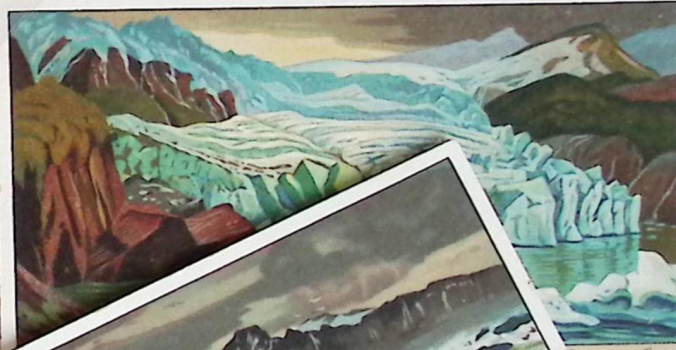

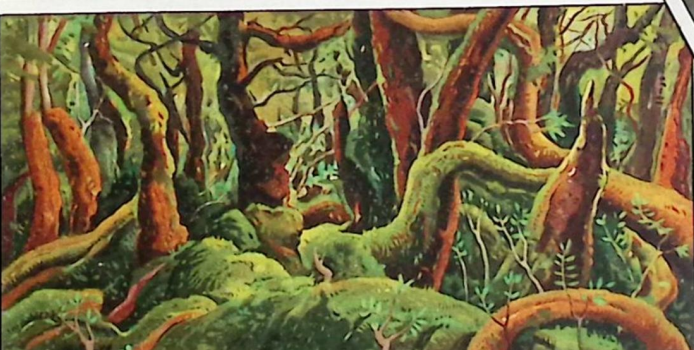
