Sirs

I beg to acknowledge the receipt
of yours of the 19th March.

The amount of the Bill which
I sent Capt. Lewis is £60..3..0 viz.
£31..15..0 due at the time of Mrs Phillips's
Death and £28..8..0 due since her Death.

Capt. Lewis placed the little Boy
under my care and I have a letter of his
in my possession to prove that fact.

I can also prove that when Mr Phillips
took Master Lloyd from my house and sent him
to lodgings Capt. Lewis immediately interfered
and ordered the little Boy to be sent back
to me.

There are two things then which render

Capt. Lewis responsible to me for the whole of my demand: -

1. His letter to me in July 1835 before Master Lloyd entered my school.

2. His subsequent (very proper) interference in August 1837.

I still indulge the hope that Capt. Lewis will see the propriety of paying the whole of my demand (£60.-3-0) and indeed that he is in justice bound to pay it.
