The above are facsimile copies of the now famous "Potato" Essay: the only one of a set designed by Mr. A. B. Crawford, which was actually printed. These 1d. Potato Stamps, which now realise sums over 200 times their face of one penny or "4 potatoes", were included in a longer set submitted to the Secretary of State for the Colonies, with a petition for Postage Stamps for TRISTAN DA CUNHA in May 1946. Mr. A. B. Crawford (South Africa), designed each value.
