These "Flag Days" emblems were produced before the Easter Rising in 1916. They depict William Philip Allen, Larkin, and O'Brien, against the Tricolour Irish flag. They were prepared for use by the Irish Republicans. The emblems were both gummed and ungummed.

These appeared after the 1916 Rising and were prepared by American sympathisers. The full set was printed in a sheet of 8 (4x2) and are usually off centre and roughly perforated. Seven of the designs are photographs of the patriots who took part in the Rising: Pearse, McDonagh, Connolly, The O'Rahilly, De Valera, Colbert and Ceannt. The eighth design is a harp and shamrock.
