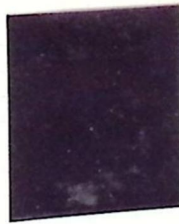

# Great Britain

The size of the photogravure stamps was twice reduced as the margin between design and the perforations appeared too small: the area of paper did not alter. following cut stamps show the comparison: ~



The only values to be issued in the "large" size were the first to be issued, the 1d. and the 1½d. — The size of the design is 18.3 mm. x 22.5 mm. \*



These two values, together with the next two to be produced (the ½d. and 2d), later printed in the "medium" size — 18.1 mm. x 21.8 mm. \*



This reduction was not deemed sufficient and the four values already issued, together with the higher values to 1s., later appeared in the "small" — 17.5 mm. x 21.5 mm. \*
