**Ex Head Plate 5 Duty Plate 5  
Rows 12 & 13 Column 10.**

**The enlargement shows the cracked plate developing in the right frame of row 12 Column 10 by the rosette, passing through the rosette and following the left frame of the right hand curtain.**

**Ink has built up in the crack during the printing process resulting in the dark ink deposits along a large part of the crack.**
