The Bradbury Wilkinson & Co printings.

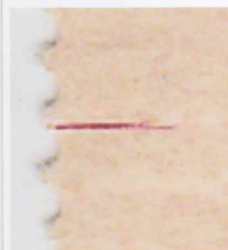
For the 5/- issue Bradbury Wilkinson utilised 8 separate plates. Despite that large number of plates only one has been found overprinted or surcharged for use in the Morocco Agencies.

All the Bradbury plates for the 5/- value had additional markings above & below columns 1 & 4 as well as alongside rows 1/2 & 9/10 on both sides of the sheet.



Ex plate 5/6 Left (state2) notice the additional line above column 1. This is distinctive to this plate measuring 22.5mm. Similar markings on other 5/- plates are distinctly shorter in length.

It can also be seen that the marginal cross is distinctly smaller than on the De La Rue printing of the 5/- value.



Bifurcated arm

Whilst these additional marginal markings are known they are frequently trimmed off as in the example above which has a noticeably less deep top margin. However it is possible to allocate this block to plate 5/6 Left (State2) as the end of the right arm of the top marginal cross is bifurcated (split).
