

Ex BPO Larache DE 14 1912 Clough Type L-2 Via Tangier 19 JU 1914 Arrived Magdelburg 25.6.14

Rate 75 Centimos equates to 20 Centimos for registration
55 Centimos for 60 grams at the rate to Europe of
25 Centimos for the first 20 grams and 15 Centimos for each additional 20 grams.
The sender is an "Engineer" in Larache.


Signed by Doreen Forde the daughter of the British Vice Consul in Larache & Consequently the Postal Agent.

In all probability accepted as "printed paper" due to that family relationship.




Ex BPO Larache AP 17 1009 Stotter Type LR-1

At the 10 Centimos rate for a 20 gram letter to the UK. Via Tangier AP 18 1909 Arrived London APL 23 09



Ex BPO Larache MY 31 1910 Stotter type LE-1

Via Tangier "8.00am" 1 JU 1908 Arrived Marseilles "23.45" 6-6-10



Ex BPO Larache 1 MR 1923 Stotter Type LE-2

The 40 Centimos rate is correct for a 40 gram letter to France from the offices in the Spanish zone between 1922 to 1924

Exceptionally late usage of the Edward VII adhesive as the George V 40 Centimos value was issued in 1917



Ex BPO Larache 18 JU 1918
Stotter Type LE-1
Very late usage of S.G.114 paying the 15 Centimos rate for a 20 gram letter to the UK during the period 1918-1921



Ex BPO Larache 18 AU 1919
Stotter type LE-4
Rate 80 Centimos = 25 Centimos Registration
25 Centimos first 20 grams plus 30 Centimos for an additional 40 grams.
Late usage of the 50 Centimos value.
