IV-37. There is a 0.9mm curved line 0.7mm below the lower left ribbon.

IV-37. There is a 0.5mm curved line starting at the pennant frame line over the right edge of the 1st E of CORREOS.

IV-37. Two scratches to 6:30 at the bottom. One is between the 1st and 2nd balls and the other in the middle of the 6th ball

IV-38. A small dot 2.0mm above the right end of the top left ribbon. A 1.0mm scratch over the left corner of the 2nd R.

I-35. Double transfer at the top over CORREO. Left ribbons and side ornaments thick.

I-36. Double transfer at the top and to the left. It runs as far down as Hidalgo's nose. Lines thru the bottom of RREO MEJI.

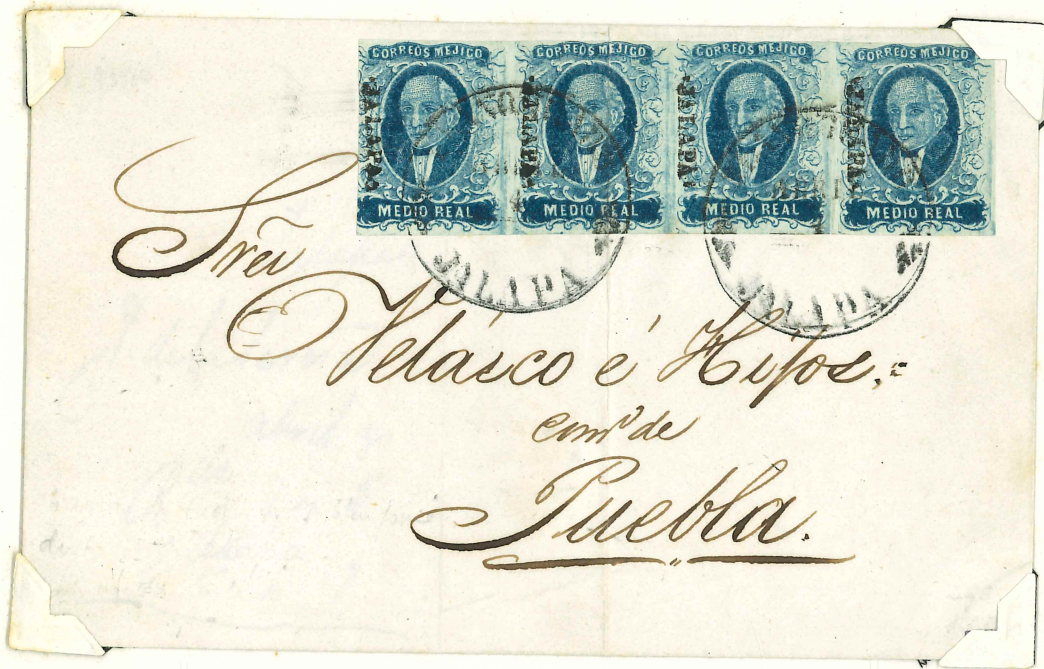

Comments

I-45. Strong double transfer at the top. Ribbons thick. Dashes through the 2nd R and MEJI of CORREOS MEJICO.

I-46. Double transfer at top. Left ribbons thick and right doubled. Dots in forehead doubled. Top left ornaments thick.

I-47. Double transfer at top with a vertical displacement of 0.1 mm. The ornaments over the portrait oval are doubled.

I-47. The lower left ornament is weak.

I-48. Double transfer at the top displaced 0.15mm. The right and left lower ribbons are doubled as are the left ornaments.

I-48. Marginal plate scratch at right running down to 4:30. The top end is 0.4mm below the lower right ribbon.

This strip is I-45 to I-48
