This cover originated in a small town in CHIHUAHUA called Villa Coronado. Since they did not have a canceling devise they used a manuscript cancel. It is very rare on cover

Mute cancels dated November 1862. Pairs are rare on cover

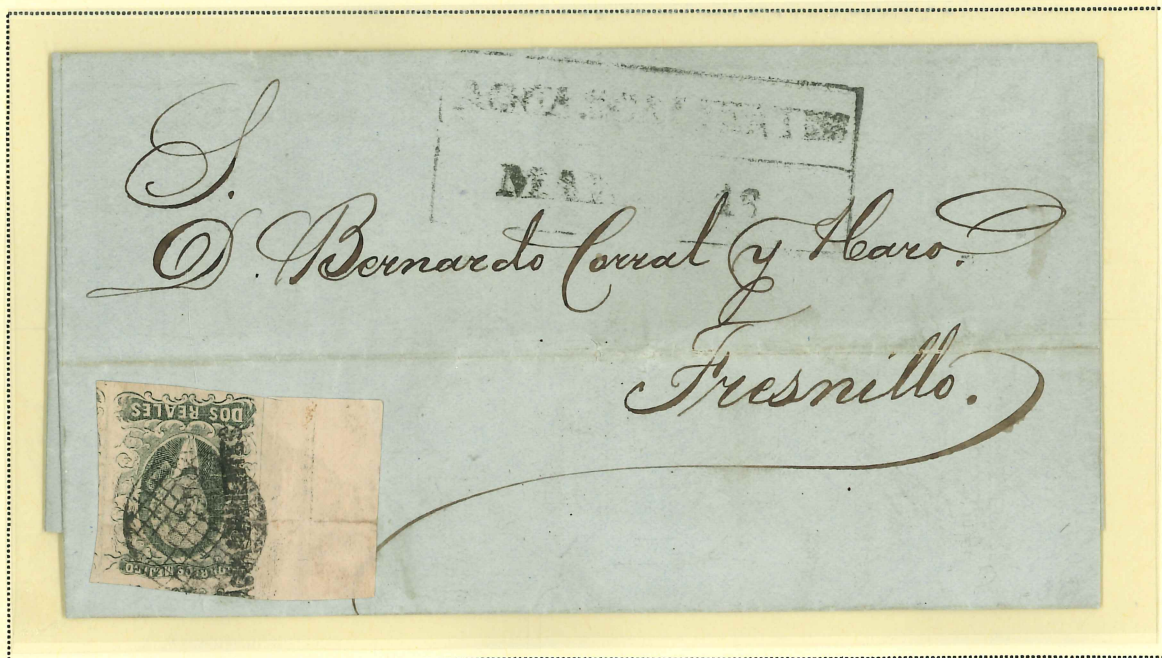

RARE DISTRICTS



CHIAPAS, Blue San Cristobal cancel. Very few covers survived from this district. All are rare



AGUASCALIENTES, With full left salvage. Less than 2,200 were sent but just a few covers are known to exist

4 REAL BLACK/YELLOW: 68,100 issued

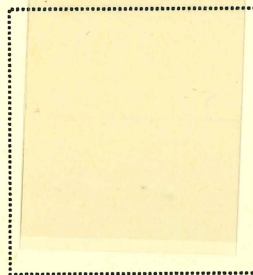
There were 2 different printings of this value in the 1861 issue, both on yellow paper. The first was printed with black ink, and the second on dull rose ink. Very few covers are known, and many of the stamps were bisected. Very dangerous unauthorized reprints exist, so most items require expertising/

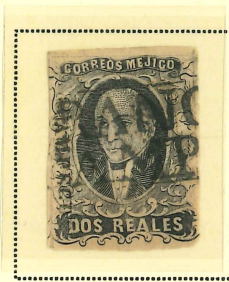

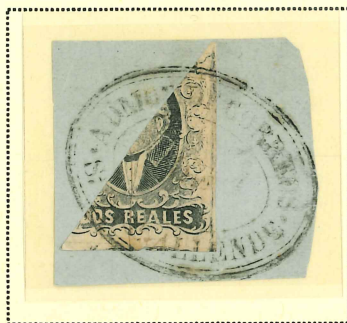
