MERCREDI, 21 décembre 1870. — RAPPORT MILITAIRE: 20 décembre. Le Gouverneur est parti ce soir pour se mettre à la tête de l'armée, des opérations de guerre importantes devant commencer demain, 22 décembre, au point du jour. Tous les mouvements de troupes se sont effectués avec la plus grande régularité, et, à l'heure qu'il est, il y a plus de cent bataillons de garde nationale mobilisée en dehors de Paris.

Rapport au ministre de la justice sur M. Delord, ancien juge à Cahors, condamné à la transportation pour sa résistance au coup d'Etat de décembre, et actuellement avocat à Constantinople. Pour échapper à un mandat d'arrêt décerné contre lui le 19 décembre, il avait dû quitter la France. Son caractère d'immovibilité ne permettant pas de le destituer, on l'a sursis pour le révoquer de ses fonctions en mai 1853, sur l'art. 48 de la loi du 28 avril 1810, statuant que les juges qui s'absentent sans congé régulier sont considérés comme démissionnaires si leur absence dure plus de 6 mois. Une réparation est due à M. Delord, et le rapport propose de lui offrir la place de consul-chancelier de l'ambassade de France à Constantinople. — Lettre du ministre des affaires étrangères, approuvant le rapport ci-dessus.

Rapport militaire de 2 h. du soir. L'attaque a commencé ce matin sur un grand développement, depuis le Mont-Valérien jusqu'à Nogent. Le combat est engagé et continue avec des chances favorables pour nous sur tous les points. Cent prisonniers prussiens, provenant du Bourget, viennent d'être amenés à Saint-Denis. Le gouverneur est à la tête des troupes.

— Les Œuvres de bienfaisance. La saison est dure et la misère est grande, mais la charité publique est à la hauteur des souffrances de la population. On s'ingénie en mille façons pour venir en aide aux indigents. Ce ne sont partout que souscriptions, conférences, concerts, organisés pour donner aux malheureux des aliments ou des vêtements. Dans le grand nombre des œuvres charitables, nous citerons la Société de secours aux victimes de la guerre, présidée par M^{me} Jules Simon. Depuis trois mois les dames qui composent cette Société ont pu établir 3 fourneaux économiques; délivrer gratuitement, par chaque semaine, plus de 2,000 portions par jour; distribuer dans deux salles d'asile un repas aux enfants; installer un atelier de 600 femmes travaillant pour les nécessités; donner enfin, en bons de chauffage, nourriture et médicaments, de quoi venir en aide aux besoins les plus urgents. Le tout représentant une dépense de plus de 22,000 fr. par mois. La Société a organisé pour dimanche prochain, jour de Noël, une vente au profit de l'œuvre, et à cet effet elle vient d'adresser au commerce un appel qui a rencontré partout un accueil sympathique et empressé. — M. R. Wallace, qui dernièrement avait mis à la disposition des bœufs 200,000 fr. destinés au chauffage des indigents, vient de se signaler par un nouveau acte de générosité. Il a versé 20,000 fr. pour les blessés de l'affaire commença hier, et a remis en

sortir 60,000 fr. pour secours à donner aux veuves et aux orphelins des victimes tombées sur le champ de bataille.

JEUDI, 22 décembre. — RAPPORT MILITAIRE: 21 décembre. Les opérations militaires engagées aujourd'hui ont été interrompues par la nuit. Sur notre droite, les généraux de Malroy et Blaise, sous les ordres du général Vinoy, ont occupé heureusement Neuilly-sur-Marne, Ville-Evrard et la Maison-Blanche. Le feu de l'ennemi a été éteint sur tous les points où il avait établi des batteries pour arrêter notre action, à la suite d'un combat d'artillerie très-vif. Le général Favé, commandant l'artillerie de la 3^e armée, a été blessé. Le plateau d'Avron et le fort de Nogent ont appuyé l'opération. — Dès le matin, les troupes de l'amiral de La Roncière ont attaqué le Bourget. Elles étaient composées de marins, de troupes de ligne et de gardes mobiles de la Seine. La première colonne, qui avait pénétré dans le village, n'a pu s'y maintenir. Elle s'est retirée après avoir fait une centaine de prisonniers, qui ont été dirigés sur Paris. Le général Ducrot fit alors avancer une partie de son artillerie, qui engagea une action très-vive.

With the issue of the first adhesive, the 20 centime black, on January 1st 1849, the first week or so was confusing for the Postmasters. If they had not received their "grill" obliterators they had to resort to alternatives.

These included using date stamps, "cursive" handstamps or in this case manuscript cancellations and sometimes combinations of all.
