- 3) Query sundry blocks of four of large design (10 ch. orange and  
16 ch. rose).
- 4) Official cancellation in bulk (e.g. on 16 ch. rose and 5 kr. violet  
and silver etc). Is this "SPECIMEN" 1894 2 kr. Rescht cancellation  
as seen on cover?
- 5) Imperfs: Are these trials?
- 6) 1898: High spot. "Poste Locale Tabriz."
