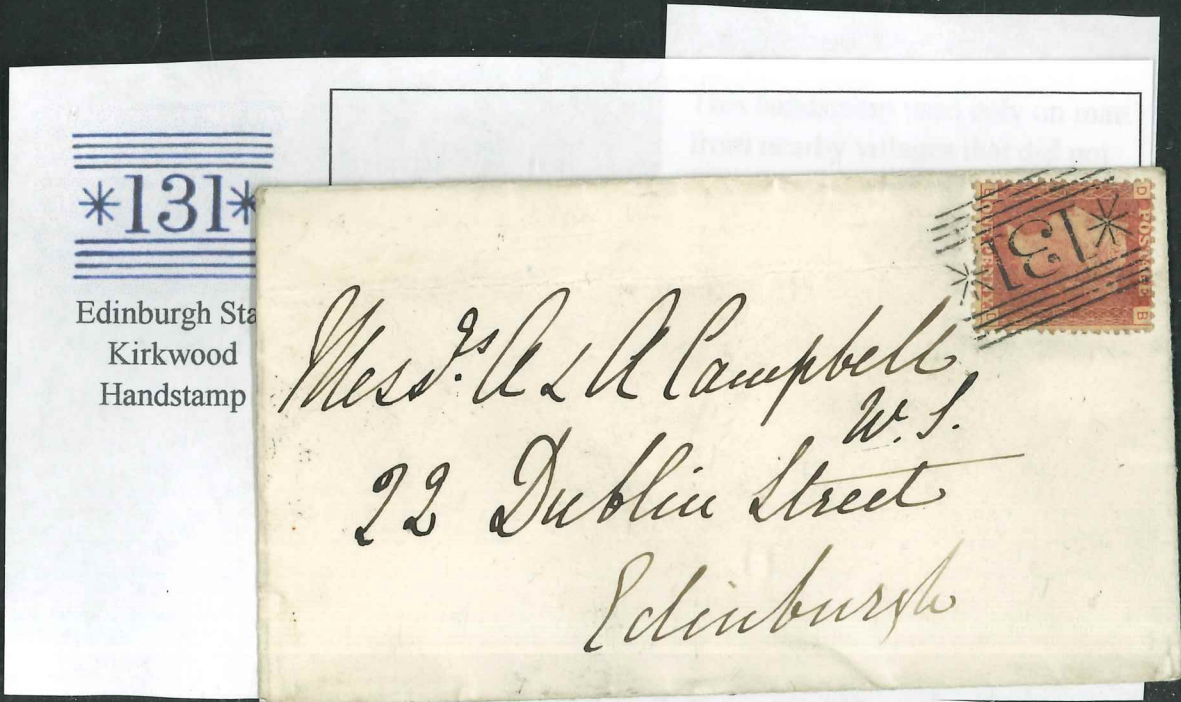

Duplex Cancellations

1860

In 1859 a small star was added to the 1855 duplex cancellation device at each side of the office number in the obliterator portion. Now for the first time we see a flat rather than a round topped 3.
