# Scots Local Cancellation

1d Red

July 3, 1855

DUKE S<sup>t</sup> LEITH



Officially authorized use of undated straight-line post mark for DUKE St LIETH (Alcock Type VII) back stamped on July 3, 1855. The stamp ties the adhesive to a wrapper to Perth and the reverse has a Perth July 3, 1855 receiving stamp.
