

5 October 1915 - Frontier Force 23 Cavalry stationery cover from Bender-Nasseri (Thvaz) to Calcutta and redirected to Sonada, India, via Mohammerah and Salkhia in India franked with a copy of 12ch ultramarine Coronation issue tied by BENDER NASSERI 5- XI 15 and MOHAMMERAH (ARRIVÉE) 9- X- 15 postmarks with MOHAMMERAH (DÉPART) 10 X- 15 transit postmark alongside as well as SALKHIA 19 OCT. 15 transit postmarks and SONADA 21 OCT 15 receiving postmark.

This is one of the only three known covers used in Iran.

KABUL TO KANDAHAR 1880 FRONTIER FORCE 23 CAVALRY

In the first quarter of 1880, Kabul was under the control of 23 Cavalry Frontier Force of General Roberts. In June of 1880, General Ayub Khan moved from Heart and forced out the British forces from Kandahar. By August 31 1880, General Roberts returned to Kandahar and defeated General Ayub Khan forces by the next day.
