Picture heavily **displaced** to the right

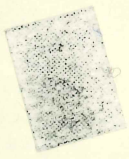
Thus the envelope was refused as per crayon mark across

From Tabriz in 1878 and sent via Russia and Berlin, Germany as per German registration label to London Received 26 Oct 1878 (reverse)

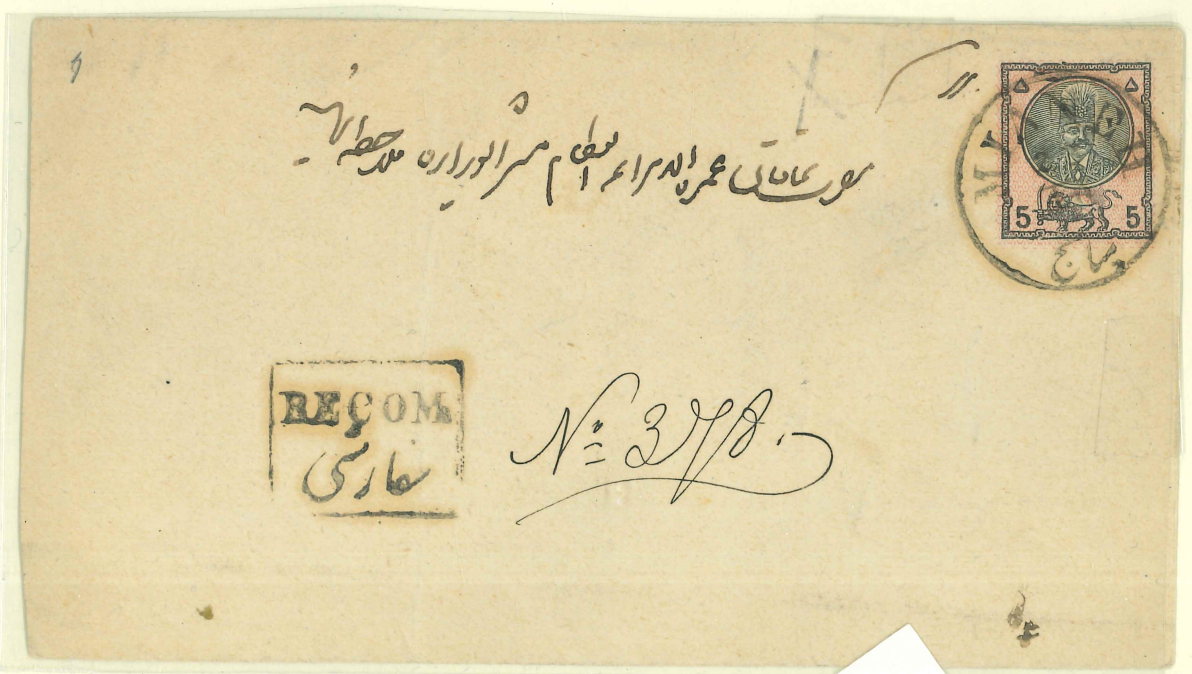

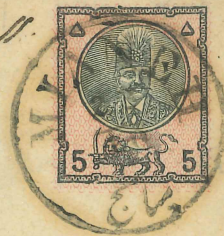

A 5-chahi envelope in black and rose were ordered from the Austrian Government Printing Office

Mint with a spacing of 6mm

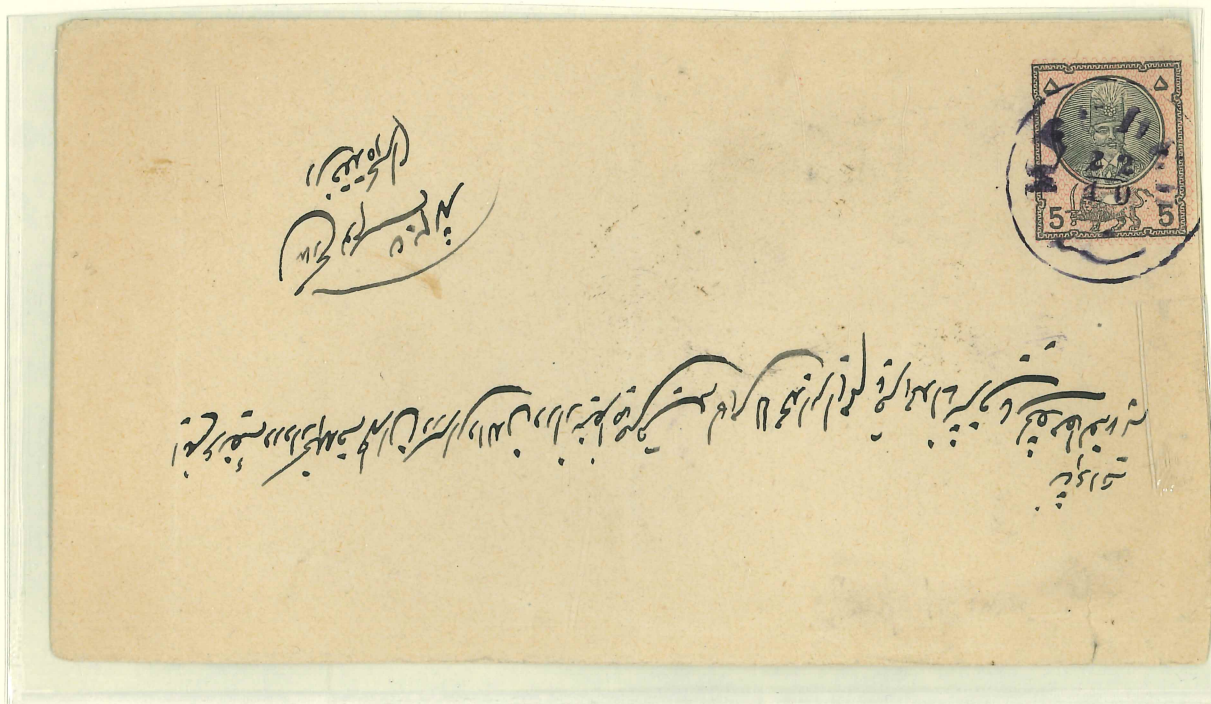
Envelope sent to Constantinople 1881
