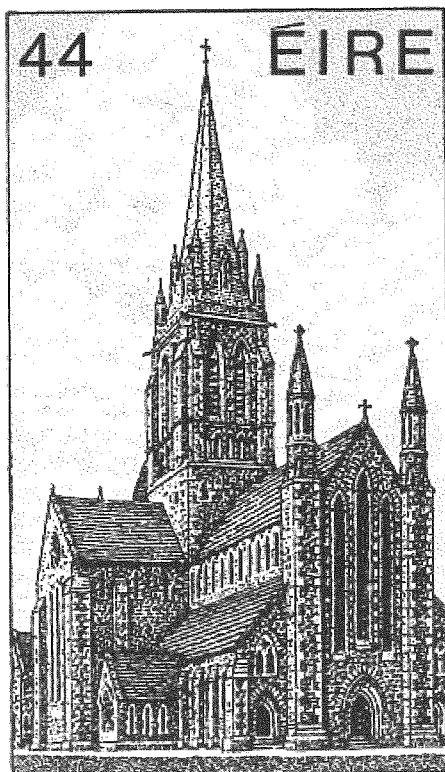
In 1982 the Irish Postal Authority progressively released a new series of 28 definitive stamp values, featuring nine buildings (see pages 9, 10, 11), which are of architectural and historical importance.

The stamp designs are taken from line drawings by Michael Craig, with graphics by Peter Wildbur.

Sheet and booklet stamps were printed by the Irish Security Stamp Printers Ltd. (ISSP), using the lithography process.

The Architectural definitive stamps incorporate the following features, which are highlighted below, but not necessarily in order of importance or in terms of timing:

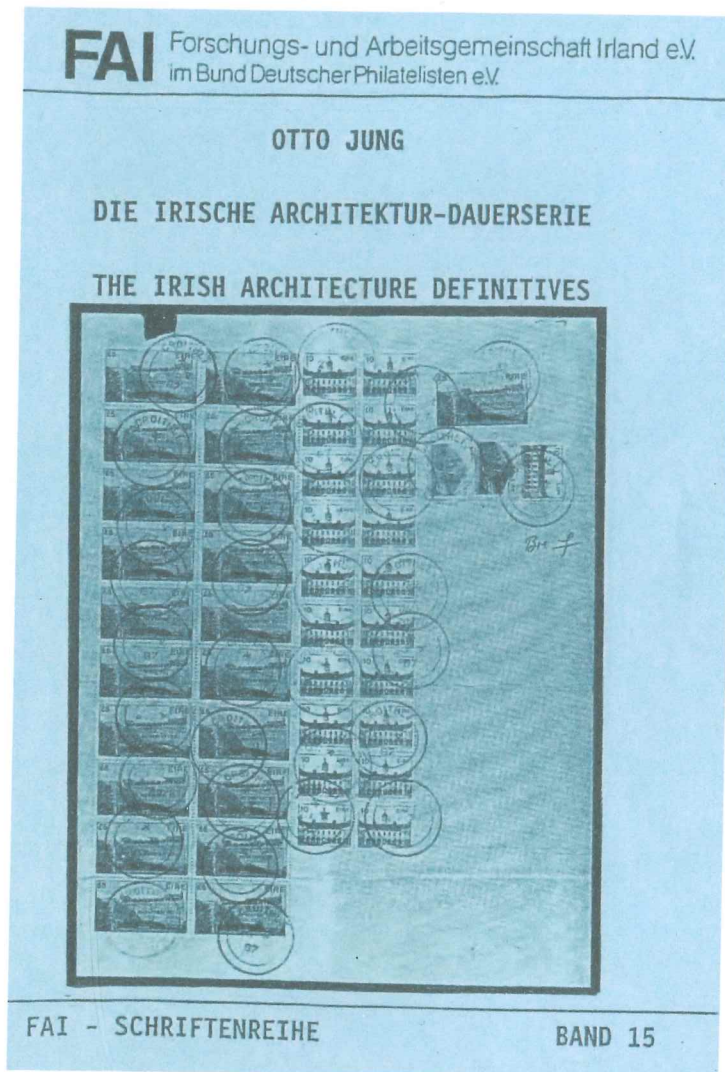
- A) Decimal Sheet Stamps, with un-watermarked paper, lithography (litho) printed. (ISSP)
- B) Booklet Stamps in se-tenant panes with part imperforate edges, litho printed, with sheet size and larger formats. (ISSP)
Se-tenant panes from this issue also occur with combinations from the 'Heritage & Treasures' definitive issue.
Uniquely some panes from this issue display an imprint on the gummed face, which reads 'Booklet Stamp'.
- C) Coated printing papers CCP1, CCP3 sourced from Harrison and possibly Tullis Russell. CCP2 paper also in use with the £1 stamp, in addition to CCP1 & CCP3.
- D) Three formulations of PVA gum were in use - gC1a (pale blue-green) and gC1b (creamy white) with CCP1 paper, and gC3 (off white to cream) with CCP3 paper.
- E) Four different 'Grover' sheet perforation settings, as a result of tooling deviations, were in use with this issue - types G1, G2, G3, G4.
- F) Stamp values from 1p. to 39p. are monocolour, with values 44p. to £5 dual colour with addition of grey.

This postal forgery — originally produced to defraud the Irish Post Office, not collectors — surfaced shortly after the appearance of the authentic £1 Cahir Castle definitive in Ireland's Buildings series. (In fact, most of the forgeries appear to have been used for fiscal purposes, affixed to savings cards to pay television license fees and telephone bills.) The counterfeit was lithographed in panes of 20 copies, apparently from an original plate stolen from the printers. Consequently, the design is a very close imitation of that of the genuine stamp. When the forgery was detected, the Irish Post Office quickly recalled all of the stamps and reissued the design in gray and dull blue in 1985 (Scott 644) instead of the original gray and brown. It is said to be illegal for individuals to possess the forgeries in Ireland.

Forgery: As is almost always the case, the forgers made one glaring error that permits ready identification of this counterfeit: it is line perforated in gauge 15. Minute design differences apparently exist, but an insufficient number of forgeries have been examined to determine if these variations are constant.

Genuine: Authentic examples are comb perforated 15 by 14. Unlike their line-perforated counterparts, the holes at the corners of the comb-perforated genuine stamps are quite regularly spaced in a so-called bull's-eye pattern, wherein one perforation appears precisely at each corner of the stamp.

The Four Courts on Inns Quay, Dublin: So Much History Destroyed

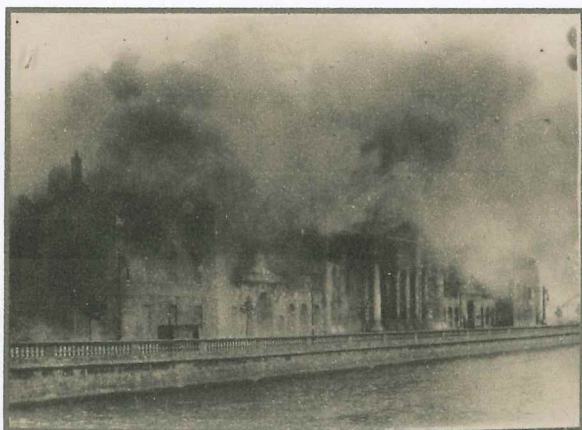
Although not appearing a stamp, the Four Courts are on a booklet cover. The centuries old nomadic nature of the courts ended with the 1775 decision to house the country's legal system under one roof. Ireland had two legal systems. Within the Pale, English law prevailed. Justice beyond the Pale was administered under the old Brehon laws. Passed on orally from at least the first century BC, the Brehon Laws, named for wandering jurists, were first set down on parchment in the 7th century A.D. using the newly developed written Irish language and continued in use until the beginning of the 17th century. Prior to the 17th century, the courts sat in various locations - though mostly in Dublin Castle.



In 1606 the court moved across the river to its present location for a short time but due to pressure from Dublin Corporation, which wanted to keep them within the confines of the old city, the courts moved back across the Liffey in 1608 to a new home in the grounds of Christ Church and in the adjoining Christ Church Place. By the end of the 17th century the space proved inadequate and the offices of the courts and the legal records remained dispersed. The courts were in a very dilapidated condition and the architect William Robinson was commissioned to rebuild them. Despite Robinson's efforts, by 1775 the Four Courts were in ruins again and a decision was made to build a new structure on the present site. In order to gain entry to the old Four Courts, visitors had literally to go through 'Hell'.

Public Record Office Explosion: Several hours before the surrender, at either 11:30 or 2:15 the Irish Public Record Office (PRO) block located in the western block of the Four Courts, which had been used as an ammunition store by the Four Courts garrison, was the center of a huge explosion, destroying Irish state records going back to the Norman conquest. Forty advancing Free State troops were badly injured. Assigning blame for the explosion remains controversial. It was alleged by the National Army Headquarters that the Anti-treaty forces deliberately booby-trapped the PRO to kill advancing Free State troops. Tim Healy, a government supporter, later alleged that the explosion was the result of land mines laid before the surrender, which exploded after the surrender. However, a study of the battle concluded that the explosion was caused by fires ignited by the shelling of the Four Courts, which eventually reached two truck loads of gelignite in the munitions factory. A towering mushroom cloud rose 200 feet over the Four Courts. Calton Younger identified three explosions: "two beneath the Records Office at about 2.15 [pm] and another at the back of the building at about 5 o'clock".

The arches alongside the main building lead to courtyards as seen in the photo  on the booklet cover.

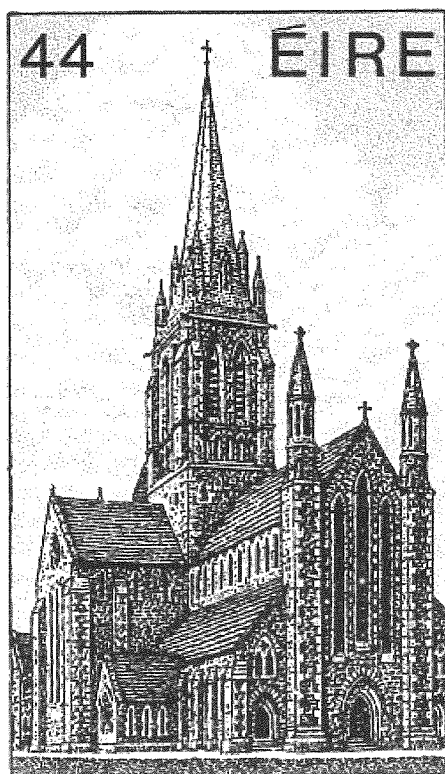
In 1982 the Irish Postal Authority progressively released a new series of 28 definitive stamp values, featuring nine buildings (see pages 9, 10, 11), which are of architectural and historical importance.

The stamp designs are taken from line drawings by Michael Craig, with graphics by Peter Wildbur.

Sheet and booklet stamps were printed by the Irish Security Stamp Printers Ltd. (ISSP), using the lithography process.

The Architectural definitive stamps incorporate the following features, which are highlighted below, but not necessarily in order of importance or in terms of timing:

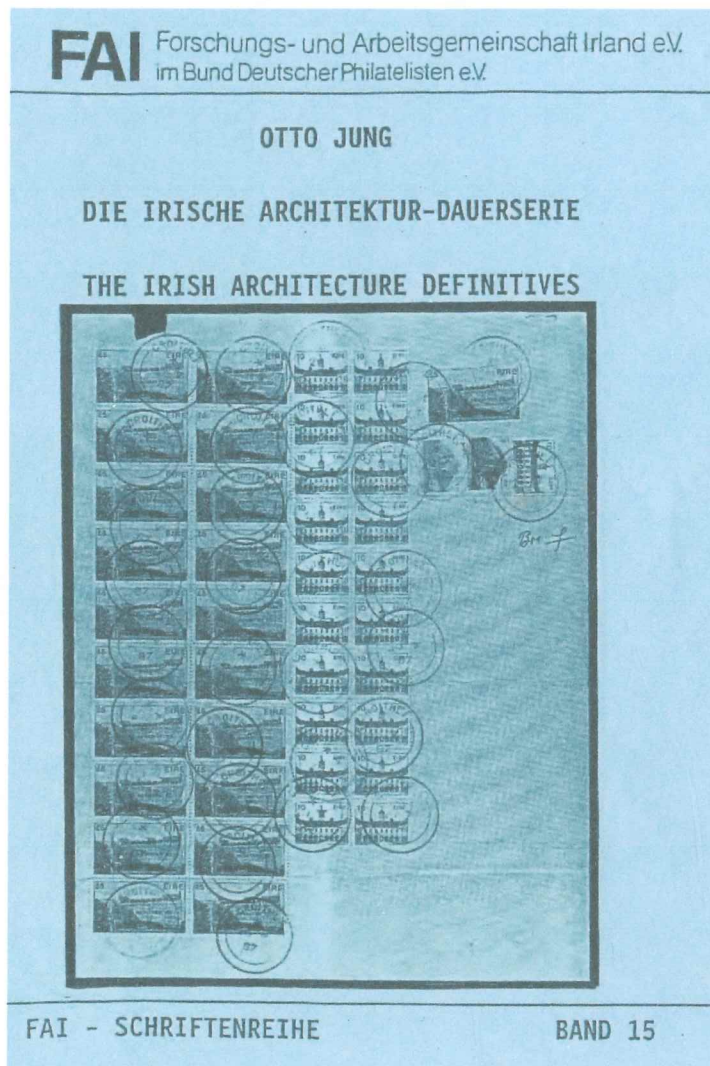
- A) Decimal Sheet Stamps, with un-watermarked paper, lithography (litho) printed. (ISSP)
- B) Booklet Stamps in se-tenant panes with part imperforate edges, litho printed, with sheet size and larger formats. (ISSP)
Se-tenant panes from this issue also occur with combinations from the 'Heritage & Treasures' definitive issue.
Uniquely some panes from this issue display an imprint on the gummed face, which reads 'Booklet Stamp'.
- C) Coated printing papers CCP1, CCP3 sourced from Harrison and possibly Tullis Russell. CCP2 paper also in use with the £1 stamp, in addition to CCP1 & CCP3.
- D) Three formulations of PVA gum were in use - gC1a (pale blue-green) and gC1b (creamy white) with CCP1 paper, and gC3 (off white to cream) with CCP3 paper.
- E) Four different 'Grover' sheet perforation settings, as a result of tooling deviations, were in use with this issue - types G1, G2, G3, G4.
- F) Stamp values from 1p. to 39p. are monocolour, with values 44p. to £5 dual colour with addition of grey.

It does appear that the UV reaction with 28p. and plates 6A & 6B appears more marked than with the other CCP3a examples you quote.

Correct, the 6A & 6B plates were printed in 1988 and probably with the best suited method developed so far. However, the catalogue value of these plates are rather low. I have found very few used items with this coating (contrary to those with CCP3) and believe the plates are more rare than the current cat.price reflects.

As discussed with Rein, the change of coating from FCP to non OBA was motivated by the content of KFK in the FCP and the present motive to escape from the use of these products in order to protect the ozon-layer.
