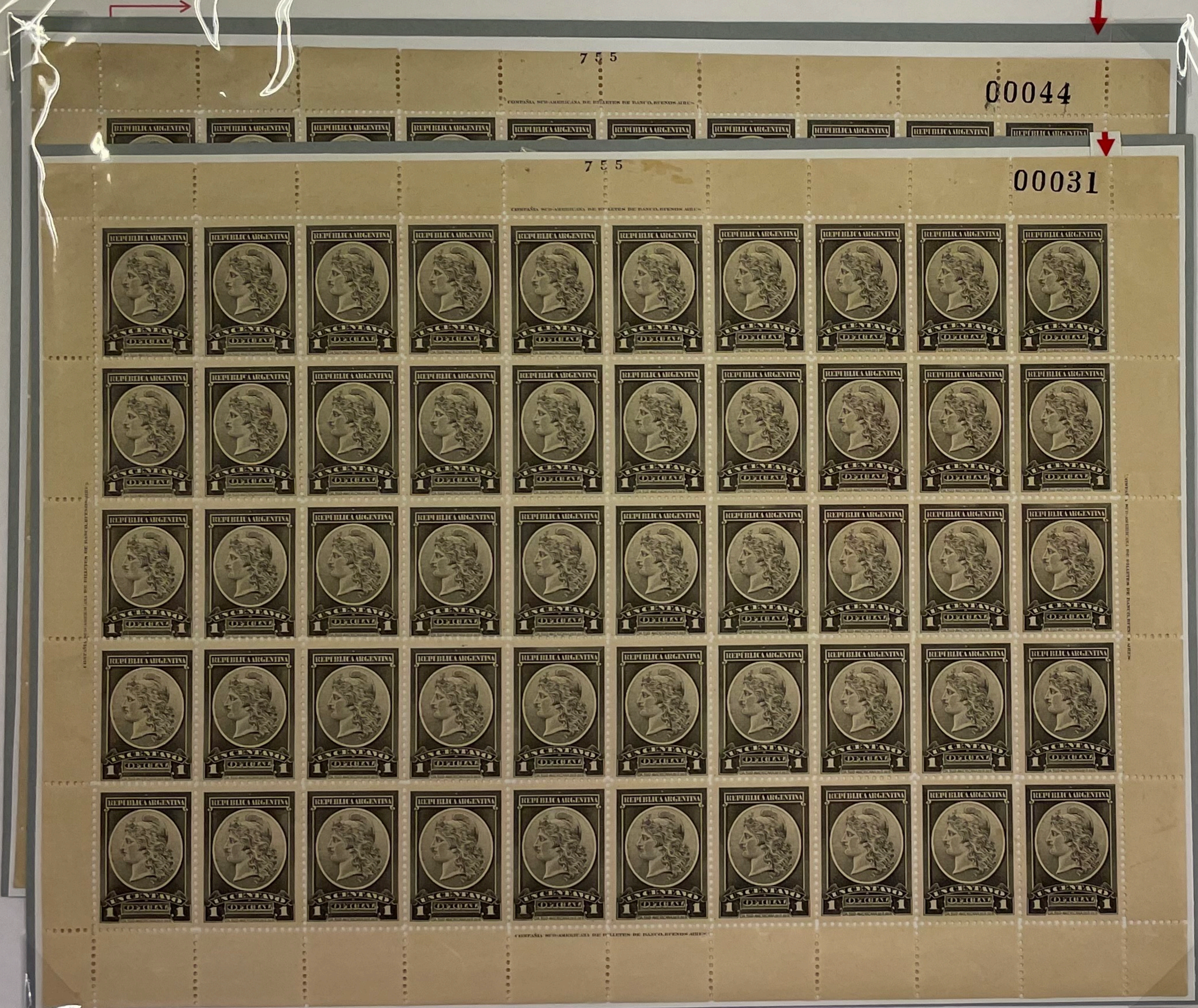
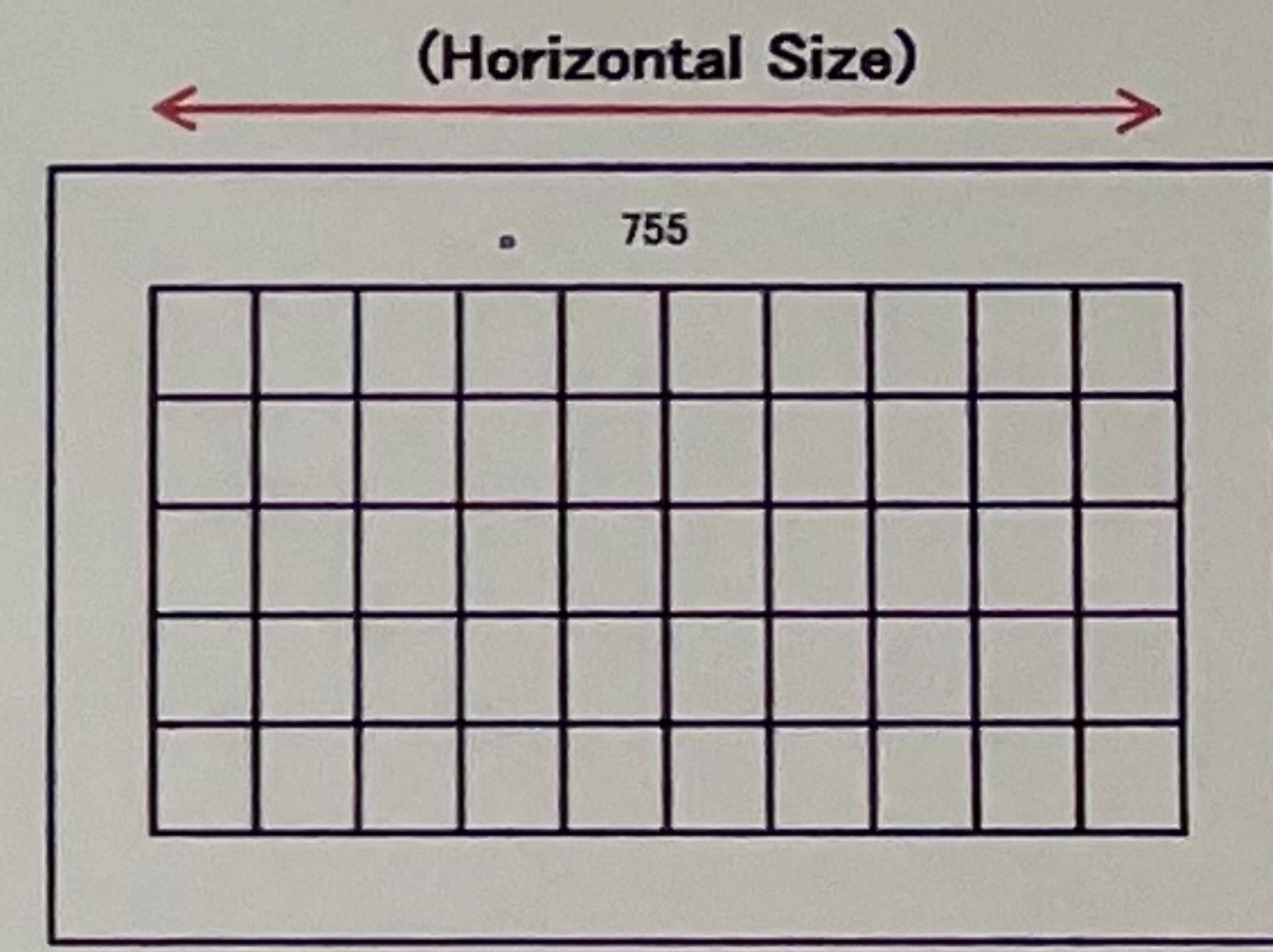


Plate No. "DOT 755" Complete Sheets with

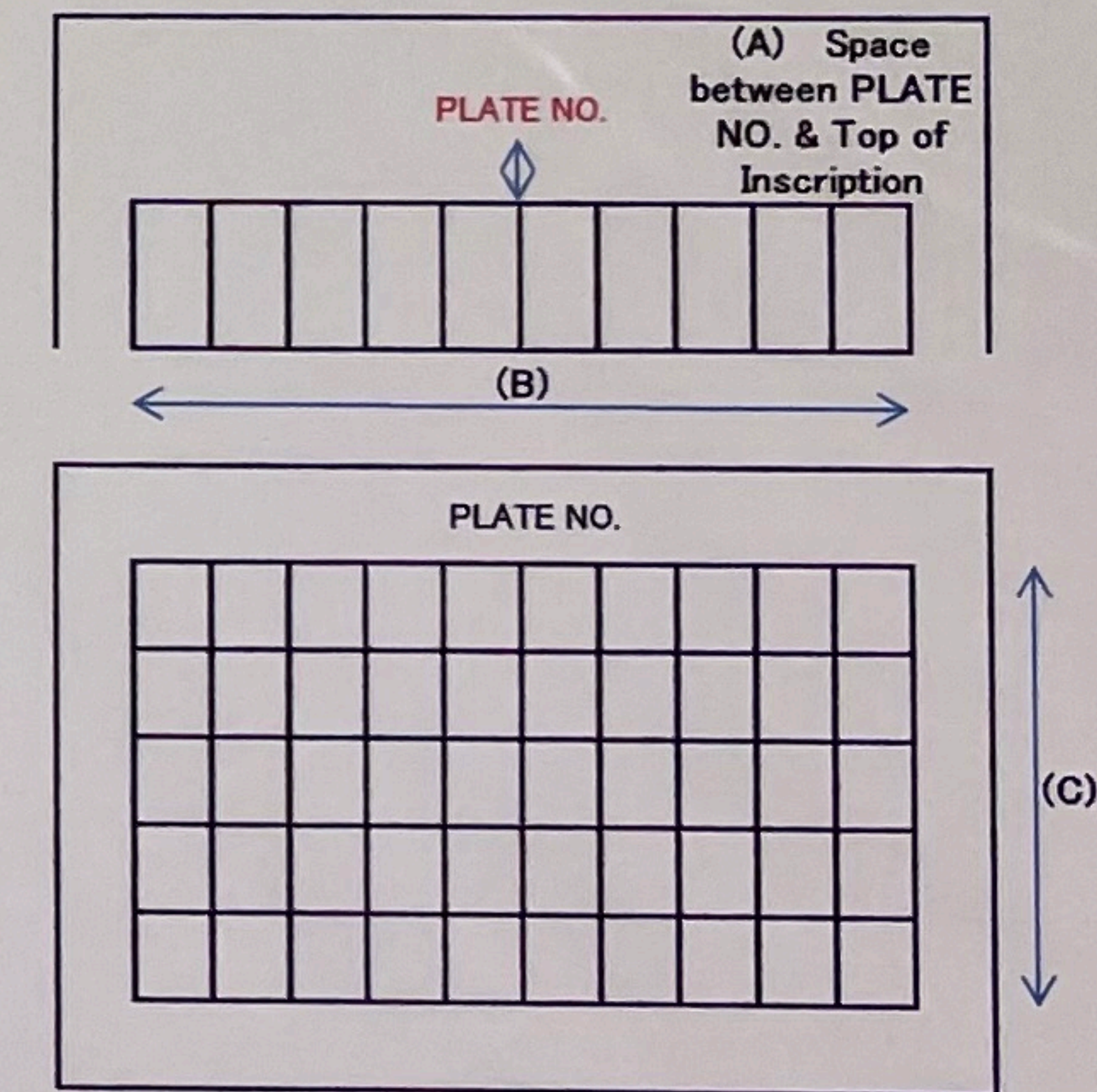
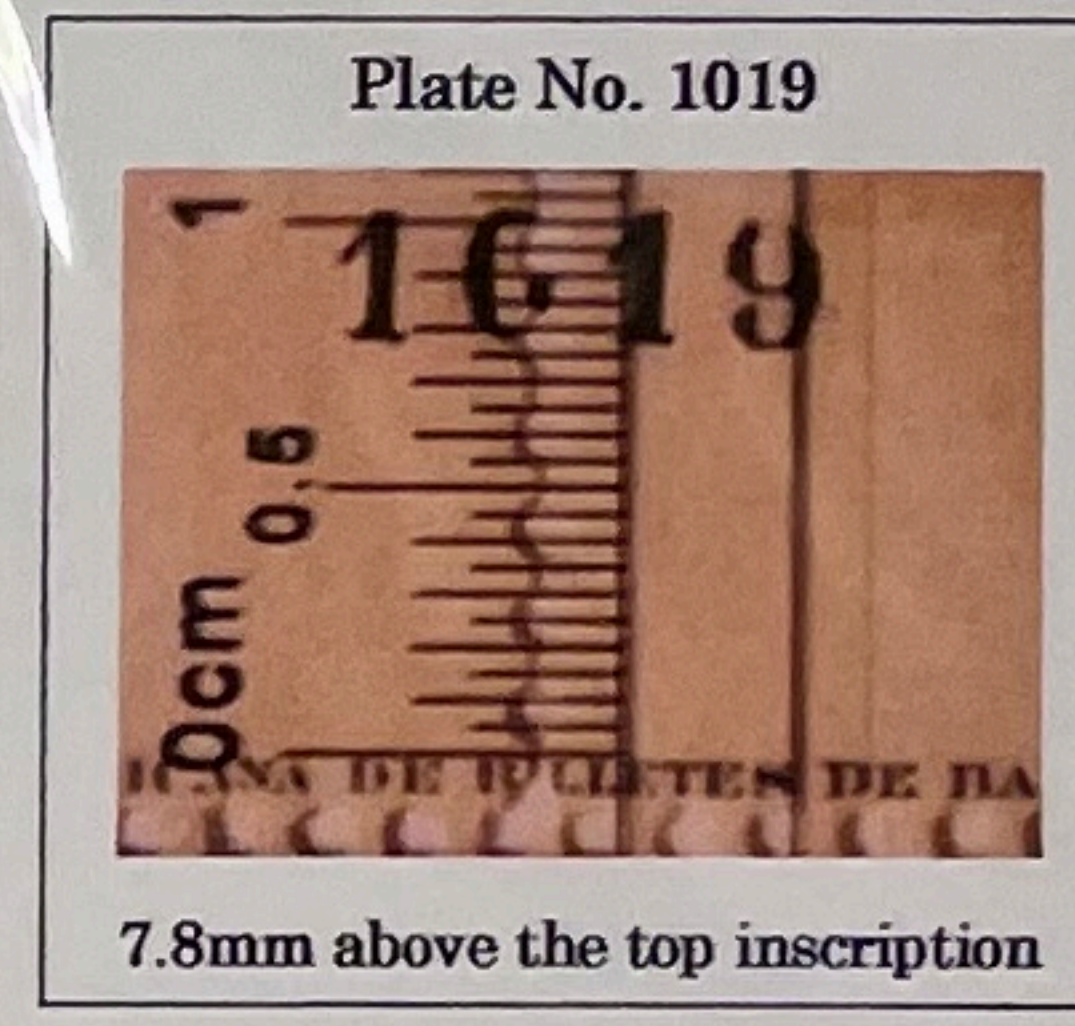

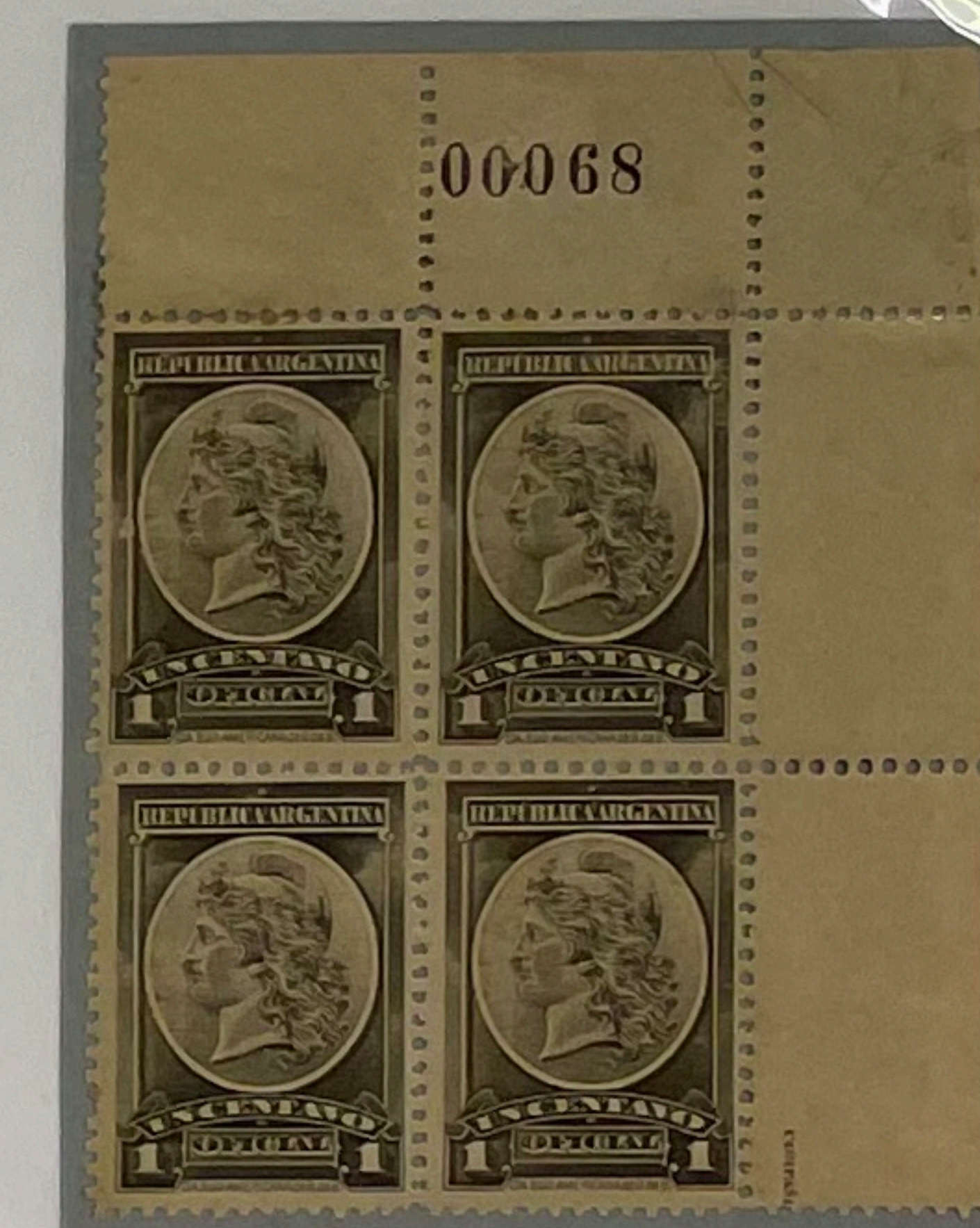

Sent from Buenos Aires to Cordoba with unclear arrival date stamp struck on reverse

2 Centavos stamps were used widely for official correspondence for regular domestic letters. This letter with single franking for a Registered Letter was extraordinary usage, and this is the only recorded registration use of 2 Centavos stamp.

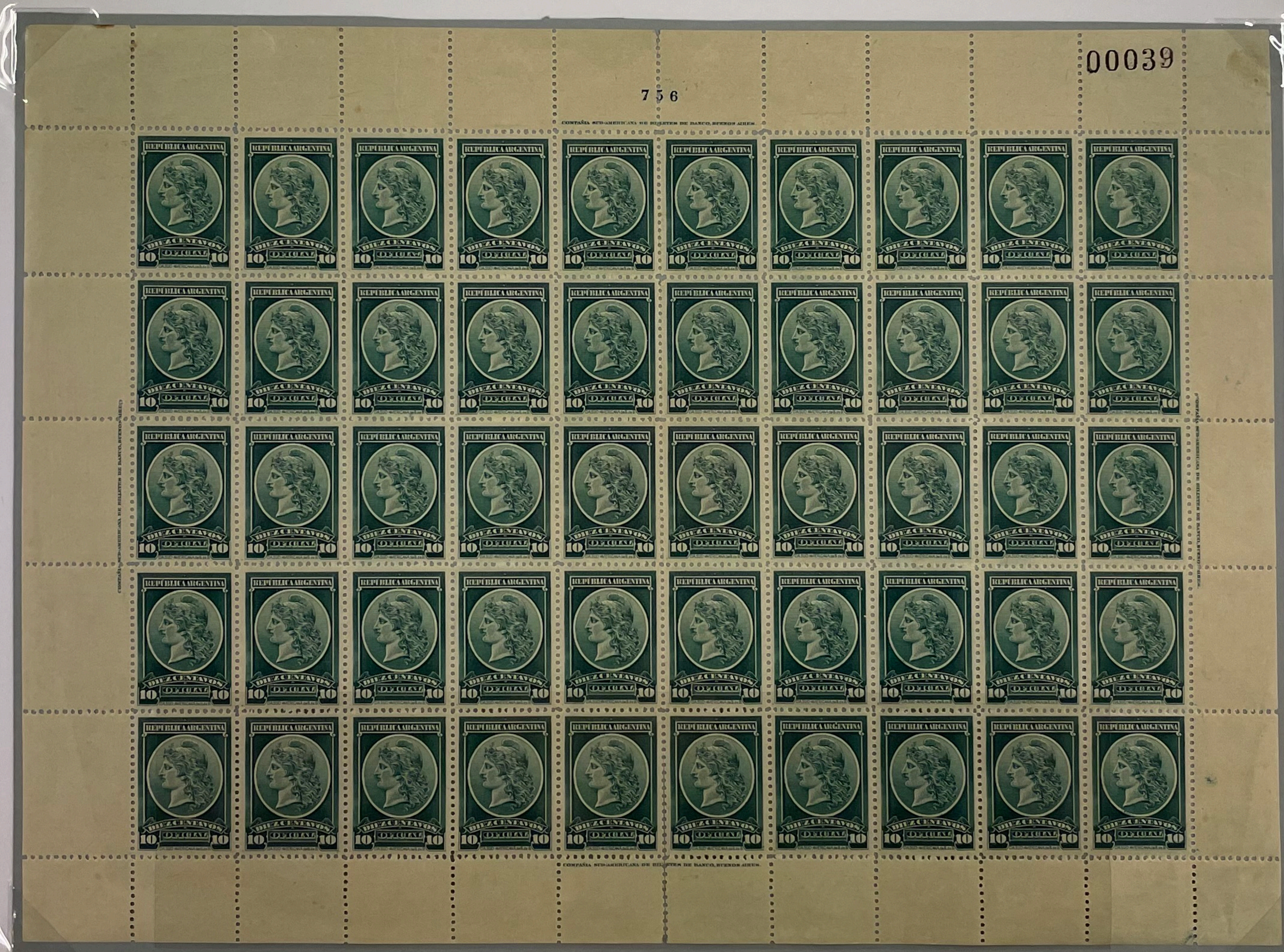

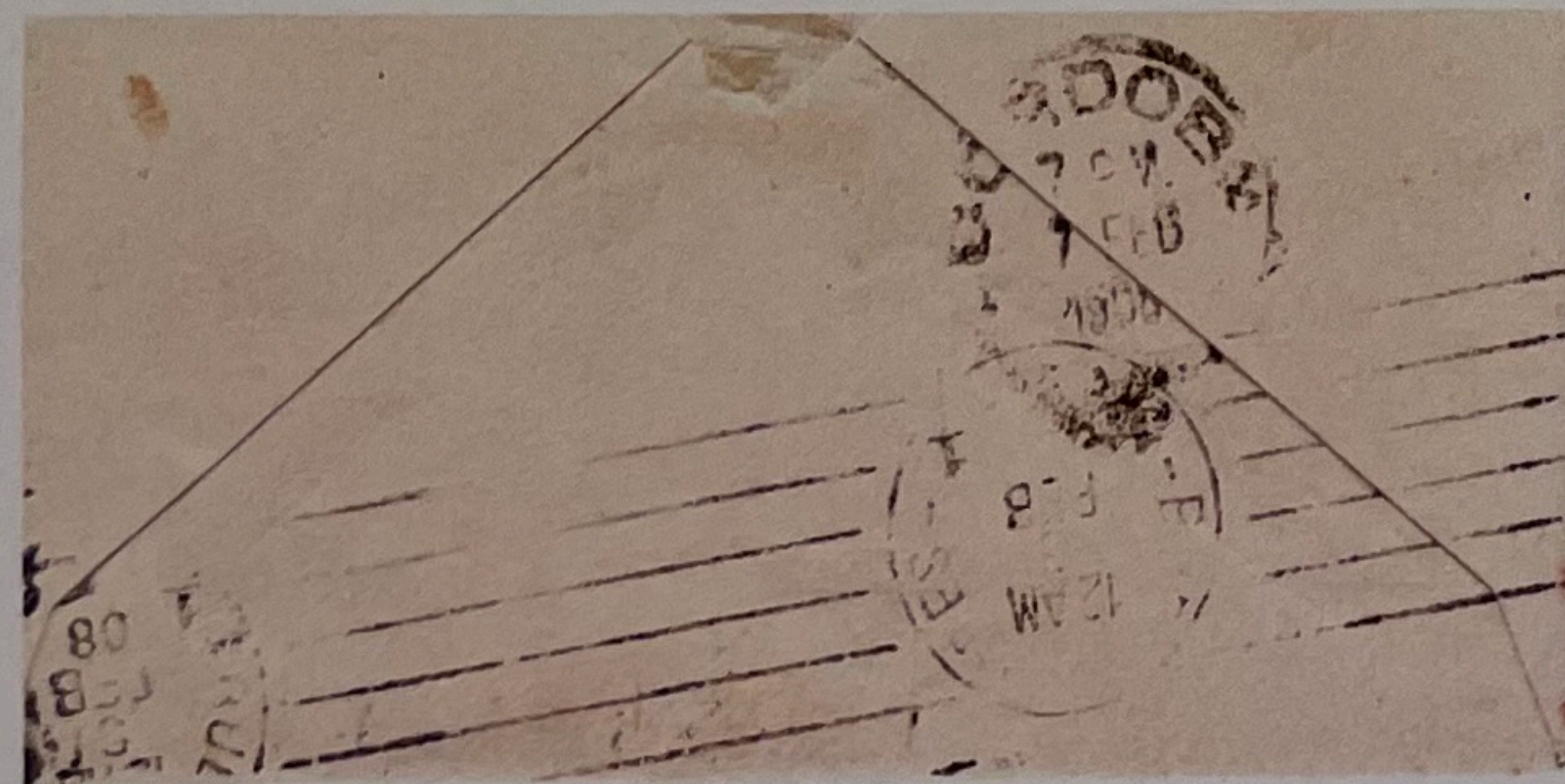

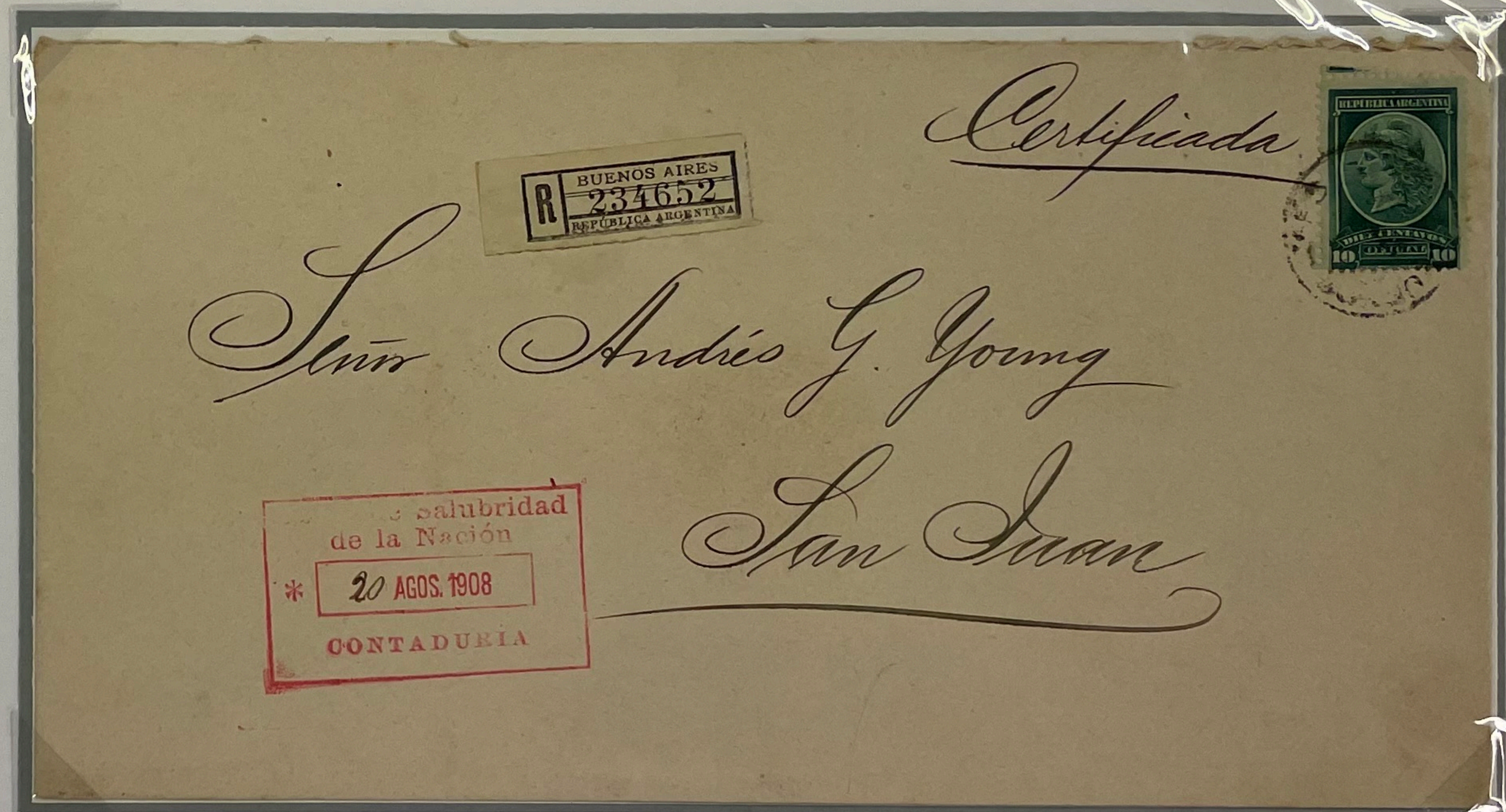

Machine Cancellation of Buenos Aires of February 5, 1908 was struck on reverse, leaving Stamp UNCANCELLED. Arrival date stamp of February 7, 1908 was also struck on reverse.

The usage of 10 Centavos stamp on cover (excluding commemorative uses on picture post cards) are recorded only about a dozen examples, and this is the only known "Registered" letter

October 21, 1904

Sent from Neuquen to Buenos Aires with arrival date stamp of October 24, 1904 struck on reverse

1 Centavo stamps were used widely for official correspondence, so that higher value stamps were used mainly for bulk and parcel postage payment purpose. Consequently quite a few covers with 10 Centavos or higher value official stamps are recorded and this is the only known example of 30 Centavos Official Stamp used on cover.

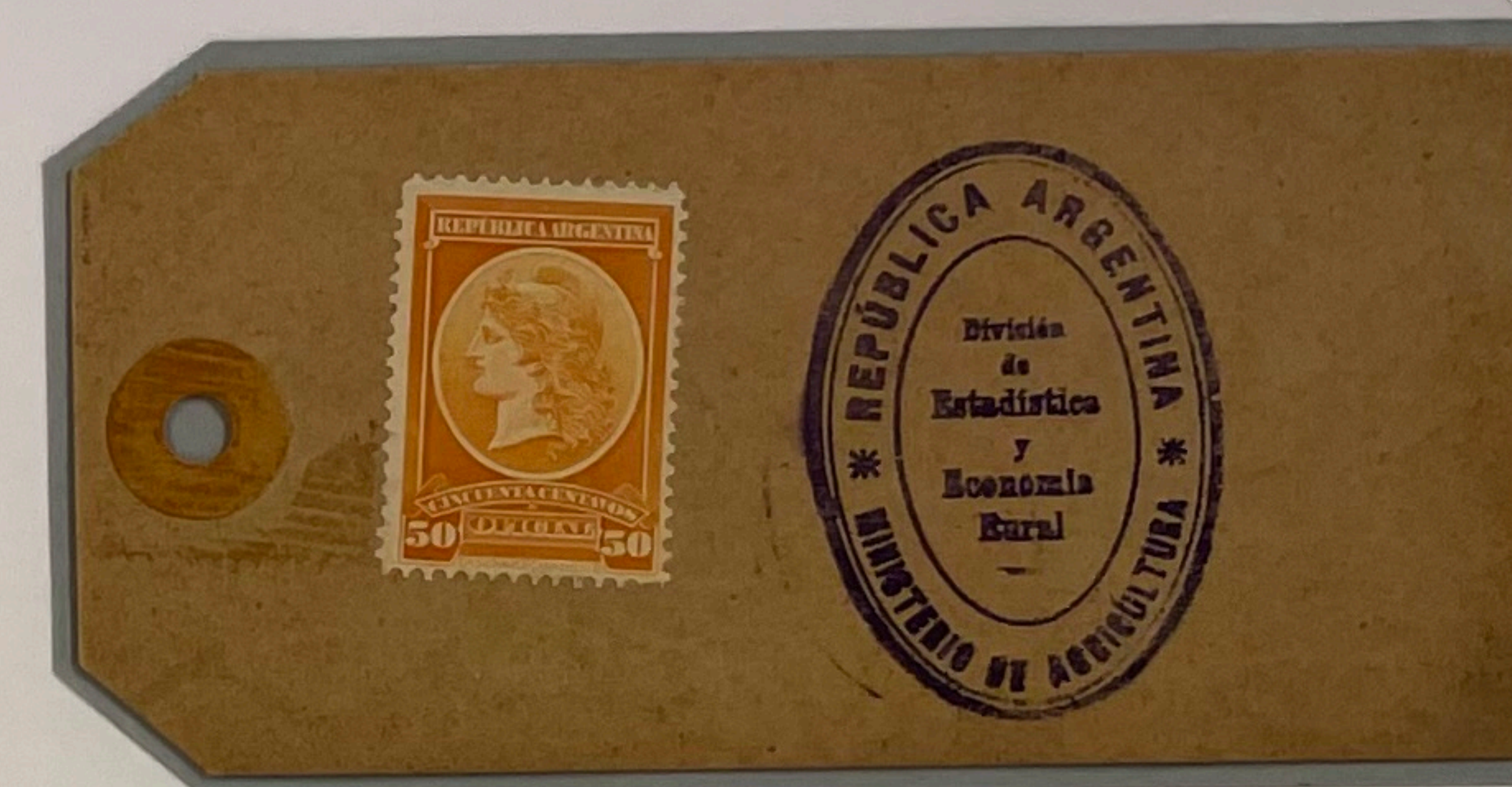

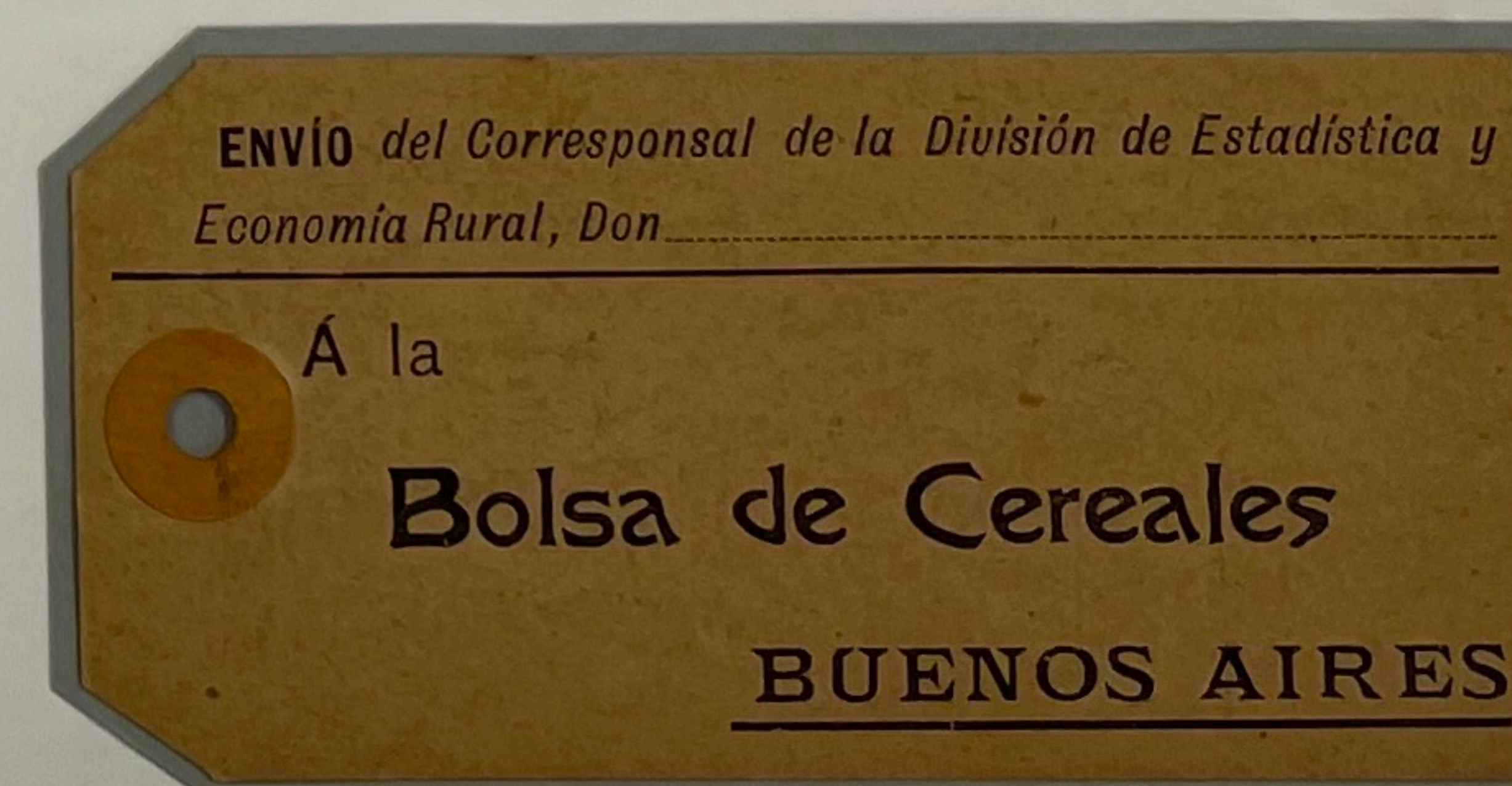

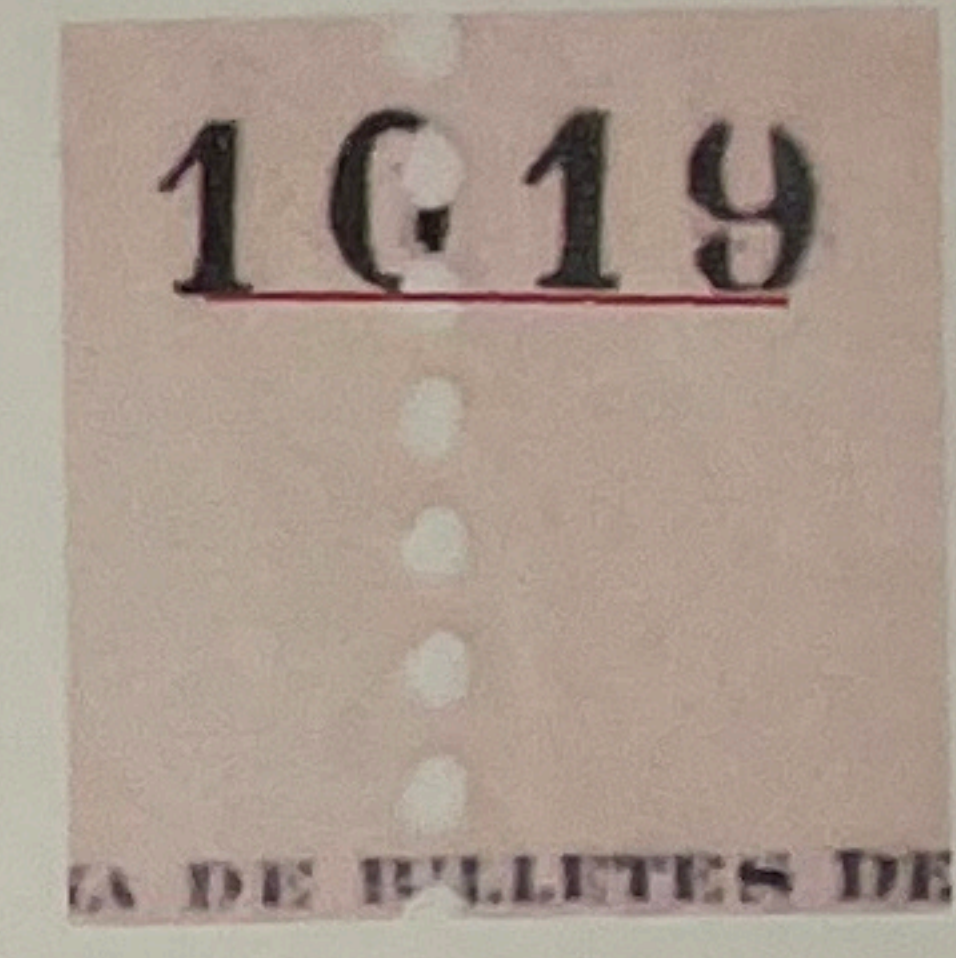

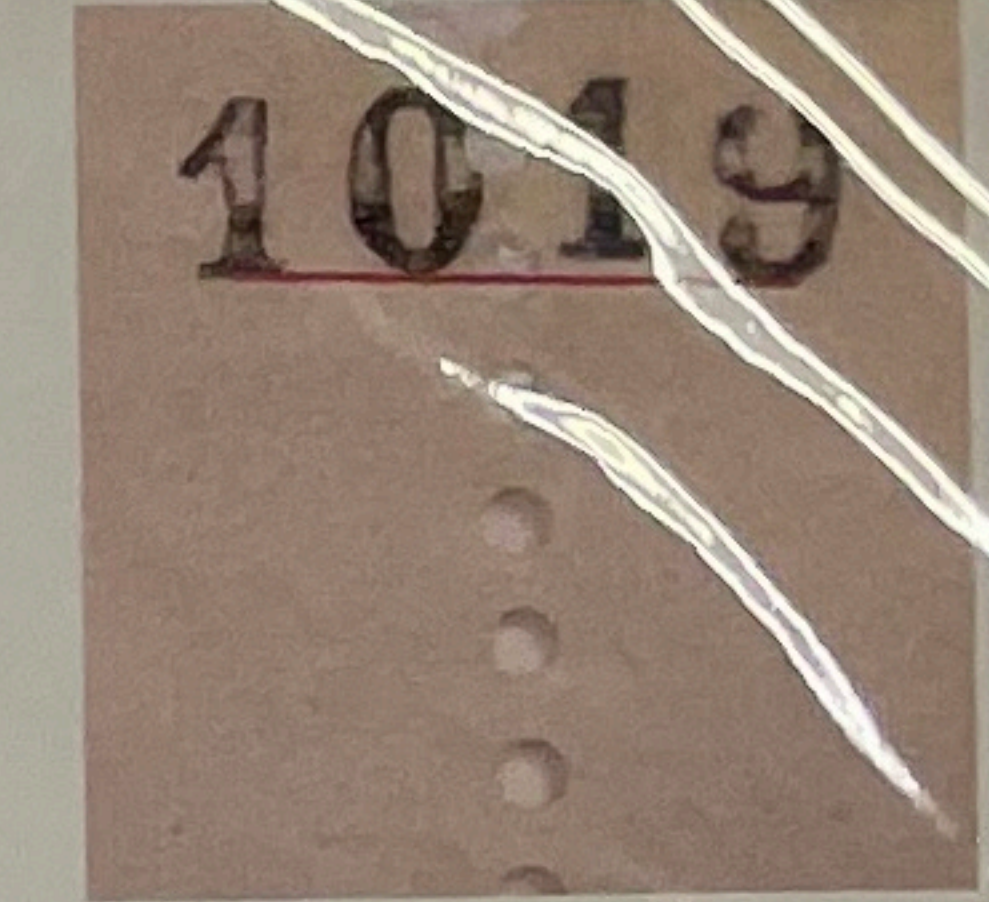

The PLATE No. printed on the top margin of the previous page shown above left is fresh and located in flat. However the Plate No. of this sheet shown above right is in worn impression with irregular allocation of figures with HIGH position second "1" of 1019. These different impressions of the Plate No. suggests existence of at least 2 different printing plates for Plate No. "1019".

This sheet is measured 239.2 x 163.5mm, which is absolutely different from previous page's 234.0 x 165.8mm in size.

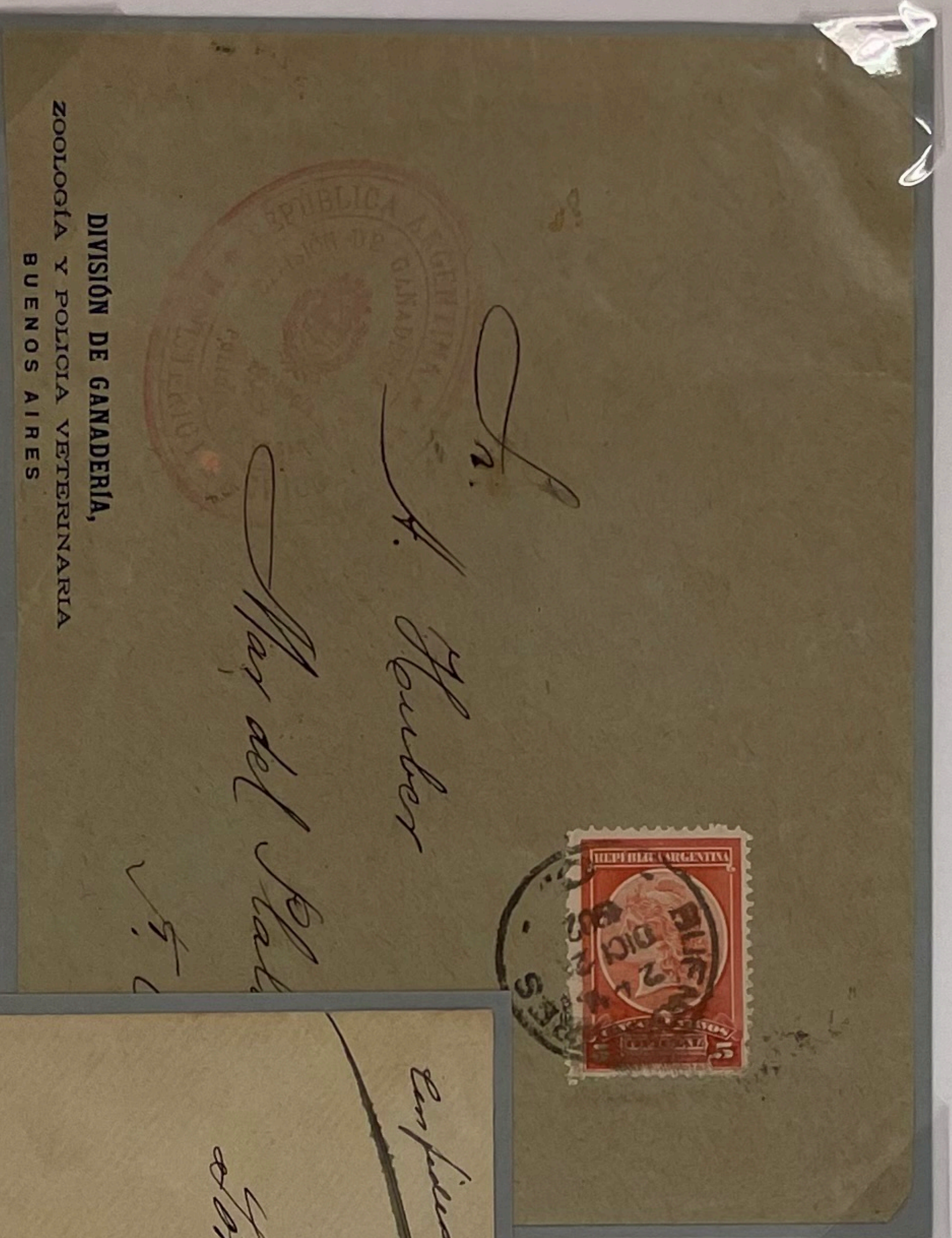

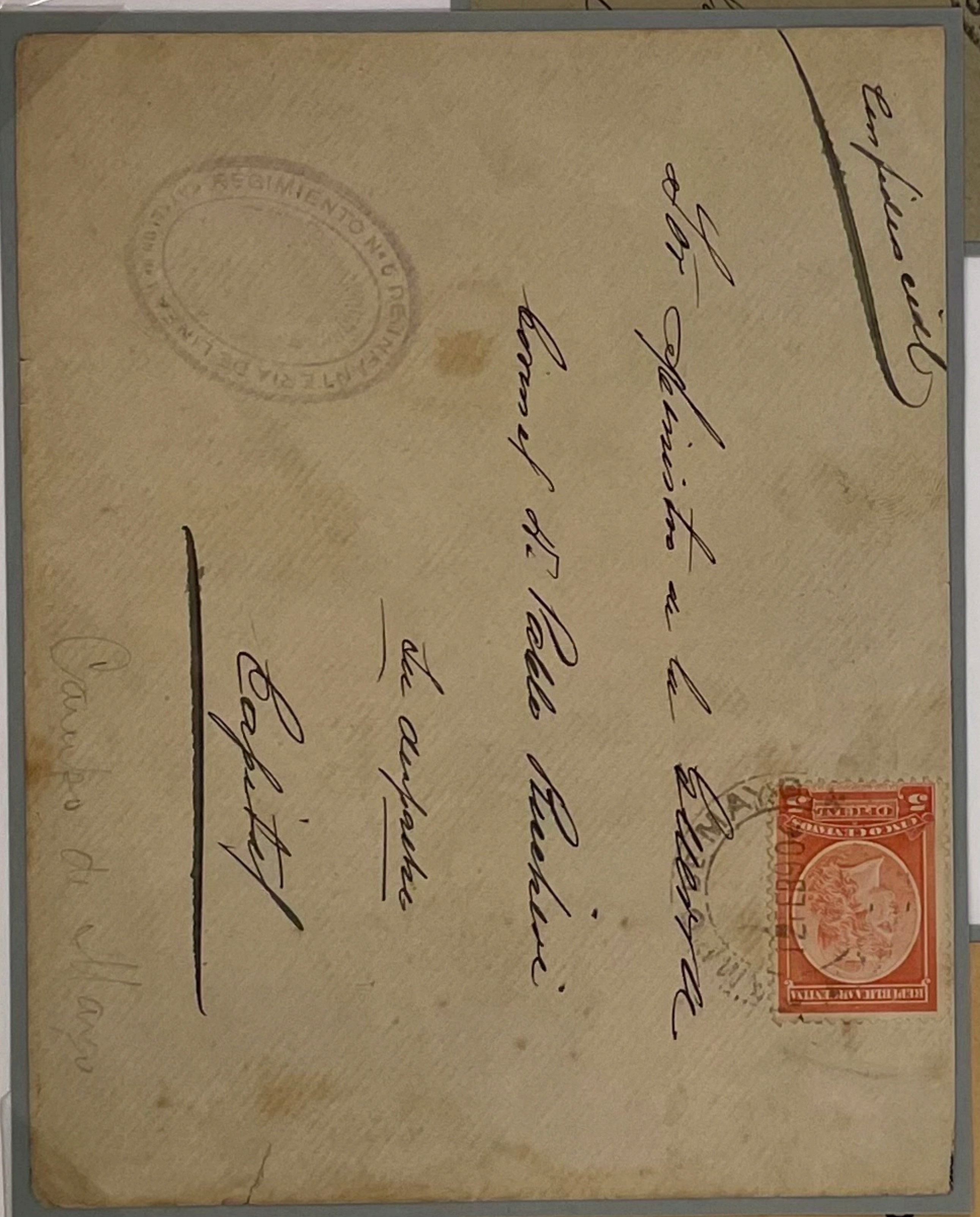
