Great Britain: 1840, Two Pence Blue, plate 1, strip of three FA-FB-FC tied by red Maltese Crosses to local London entire dated 'MY - 12 - 1840' addressed to Regents Park.

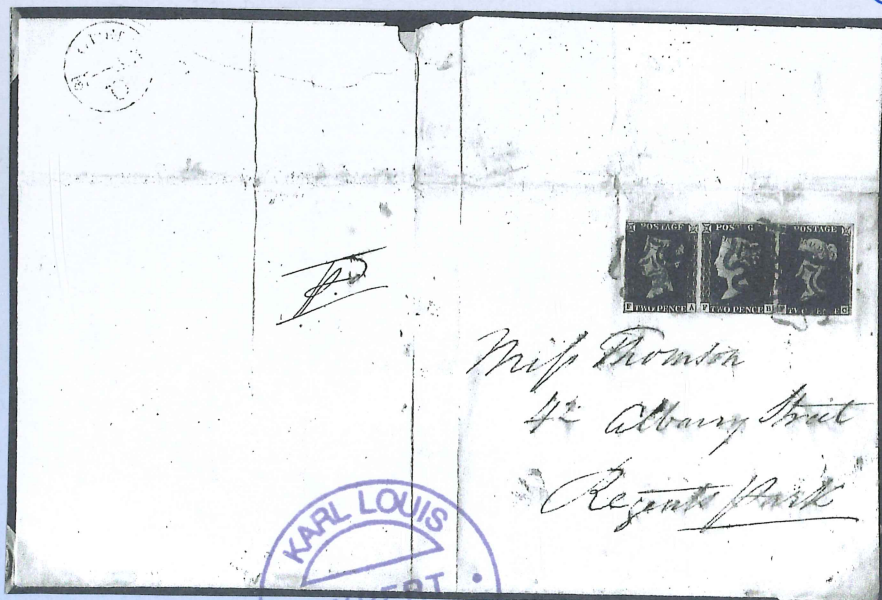
1947, Harmers auction 17 March 1947, lot 65: "...two stamps having small tears..."

1952, Robson Lowe auction 8 July 1959, lot 231: "...touched in places and the last two stamps with small splits but used on a rather soiled cover...."

1992, ex **Hassan Shaida collection**, Harmers of Switzerland, 13 February 1992, lot 381, '...FA/B ...touched, FB small tear,entire refolded for display'.

Scarcity:

The earliest recorded and largest multiple of the 1840, 2d blue on Inland cover. Only one other 2d pair on Inland cover is recorded used on the same day.
