Falck & Beidek

(1883 - 1917)



Max Bramann left the firm of Falck, Bramann & Beidek and it became Falck & Beidek. The firm sold most of what the residents of Bangkok needed. They were importers and retail merchants.

Falck died in 1888. The firm continued with Beidek who was joined by other partners over the years. By 1902, Beidek was no longer listed in the directories.

On 17 July 1917, Siam declared War on Germany that resulted in German firms being forced into liquidation. Falck & Beidek closed their doors after operating in Siam for nearly 40 years.
