



## INDORE

Also known by the dynastic name as Hara-a major State of Central India, and a cartographer's nightmare: Indore was in a large number of bits. Once the Holkars got hold of even a village, they held onto it. This meant that a great deal of state mail had to pass through other States; Indore even maintained an extra-territorial PO in the holy city of Ujjain in neighbouring Gwalior State (which only used British Indian stamps overprinted). Below is an example of use of an Indore ('Holkar') State ps card from Ujjain to Indore:
