- Bottom curl of C of CENT extends further to right than top.
- Squared bottom of right leg of N in CENT.
- Shorter left than right base of T of CENT.

SECOND SETTING

Closer Spaced Value

1863 - 75

This setting was printed from a stone with five engravings horizontally across, printed in sheets of $100 (10 \times 10)$ with the setting repeated once horizontally and ten times vertically.

Type A Flaw in the left side of 0 of 1860. White lines over and to the left of ONE.

Type B White line to the left of, and below O of ONE. Lower edge of buckle malformed.

Type C White line almost complete over and to the left of ONE CENT. Also below O and C.

Type D The O of ONE is heavily cut into at base. The E of CENT has a flaw at top left corner.

Type E Base of E of ONE cut away badly. White line to left of O of ONE.

Closer Spaced Value

This is one of the most common settings of the ONE CENT, and, as with the previous setting, it was printed in sheets of 100 in a similar manner.

Type A On the left side of the buckle a white bar has been added.

Closer Spaced Value

The sheet of 100 is made up of five types repeated once horizontally and ten times vertically. It comes in both Perf 12½ and Perf 10.

Type B There is a distinct white dot to the right of the buckle, and a white line above, below and to the left of the TW of TWO. Also, the left side of the square around the O of the date is thickened half-way up.

Type C The right top bar of the T of CENTS has a coloured mark across it, and is malformed.

Closer Spaced Value

Again, the sheet of 100 is made up of five types repeated once horizontally and ten times vertically. It is also found in Perf $12\frac{1}{2}$ and Perf 10.



Larger Type

Although this is the most common of the four settings of the 6c, blocks are very scarce and it is difficult to say how the four different types were arranged on the sheets of 90. This setting is known in Perf. 12½ only.

Type A The '3' in the lower right corner has a white cap to the right and there is a dot at the end of the lower arm.

Larger Type

This is a 'Quin' setting of five different types repeated once horizontally and nine times vertically to produce sheets of 90. It is the scarcest of the settings of the Six Cents and is known both in Perf. 12½ and 10.

Type B

There is a fine coloured line through the 'V' of 'VICCISIM', a coloured mark above the first 'S' of 'VICCISIM' and a coloured dot above the 'M' of 'DAMUS'.



SECOND SETTING

Langer Type

This is a twin setting being laid down in pairs on the stone, five times across the sheet and five times vertically. The sheet thus comprised 50 stamps. This setting is only known in Perf. 12 or $12\frac{1}{2}$.

Type A There is a break in the outer frame line above the I and A in GUIANA. There is a small coloured dot below the T of CENTS.





Type B The first S of VICISSIM is malformed.

THIRD SETTING

Larger Type

This is a twin setting, the stamps being laid down in pains on the stone, five times across the sheet and five times ventically. In the bottom two nows Type B was replaced by Type B2. There is no evidence to show that Type A was replaced likewise.

Type A The T of PETIMUSQUE has a coloured ban projecting to the left from the vertical stem. The white border to the right of the 3 of the date ahs a coloured dot.


