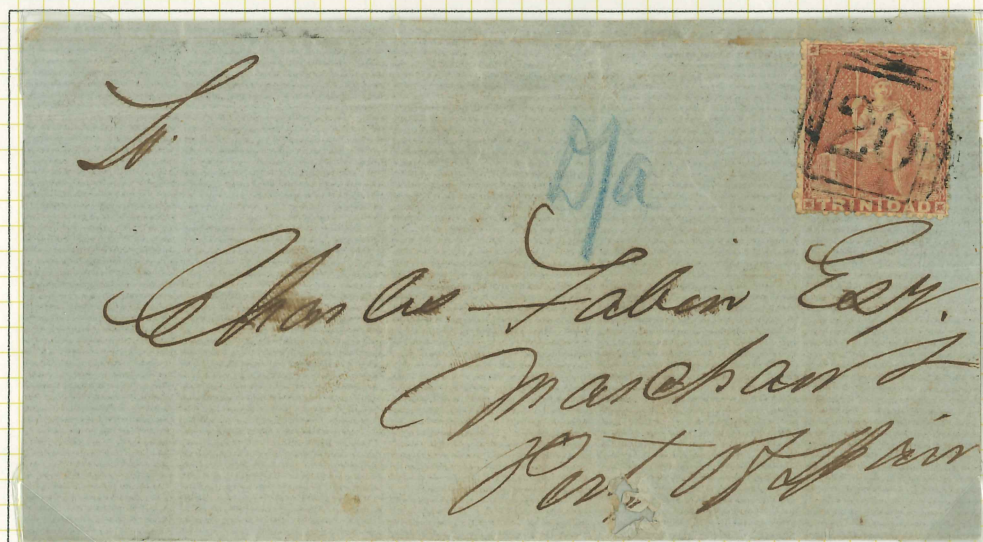

24 January 1871 - Wrapper addressed to a religious order in Bordeaux, France marked in manuscript 'R.M.S.' and bearing two double arc postmarks, each cancelling an adhesive; 'TRINIDAD PAID' datestamp in red. Inscribed '1/2' for the rate to France for letters not exceeding ½oz, the remaining 2d going to the Trinidad GPO.

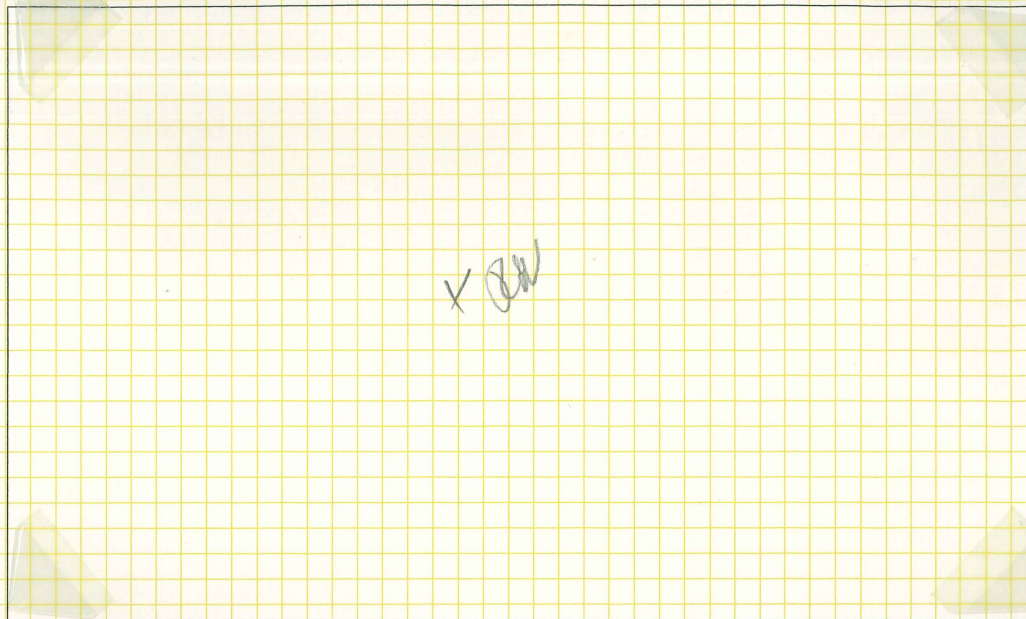

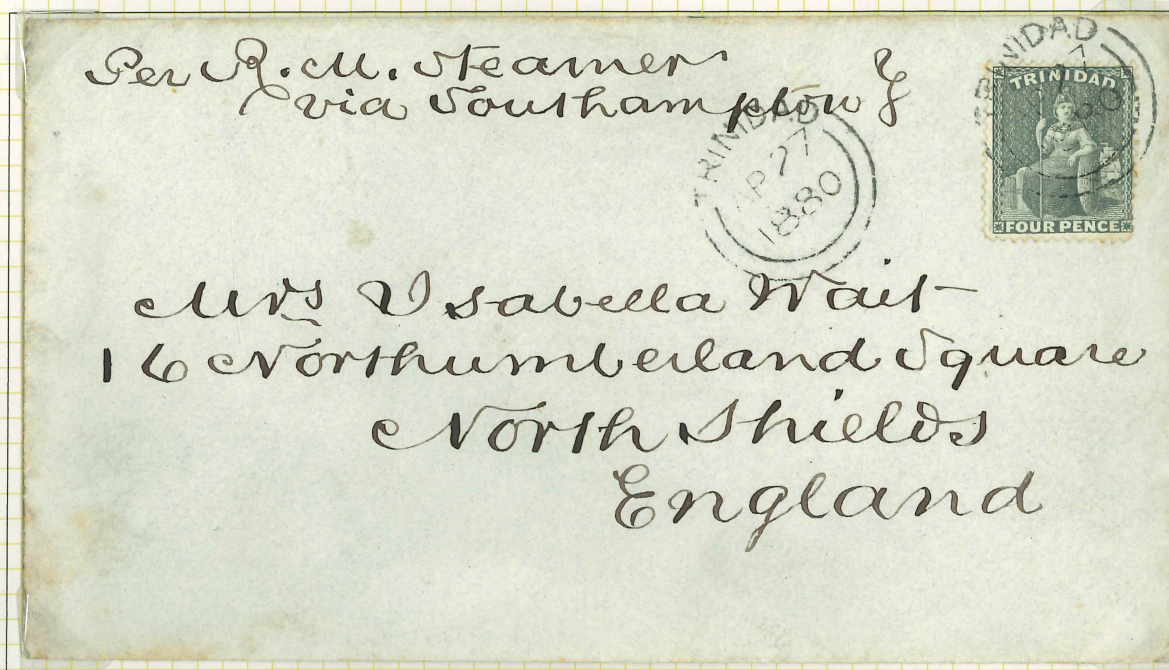

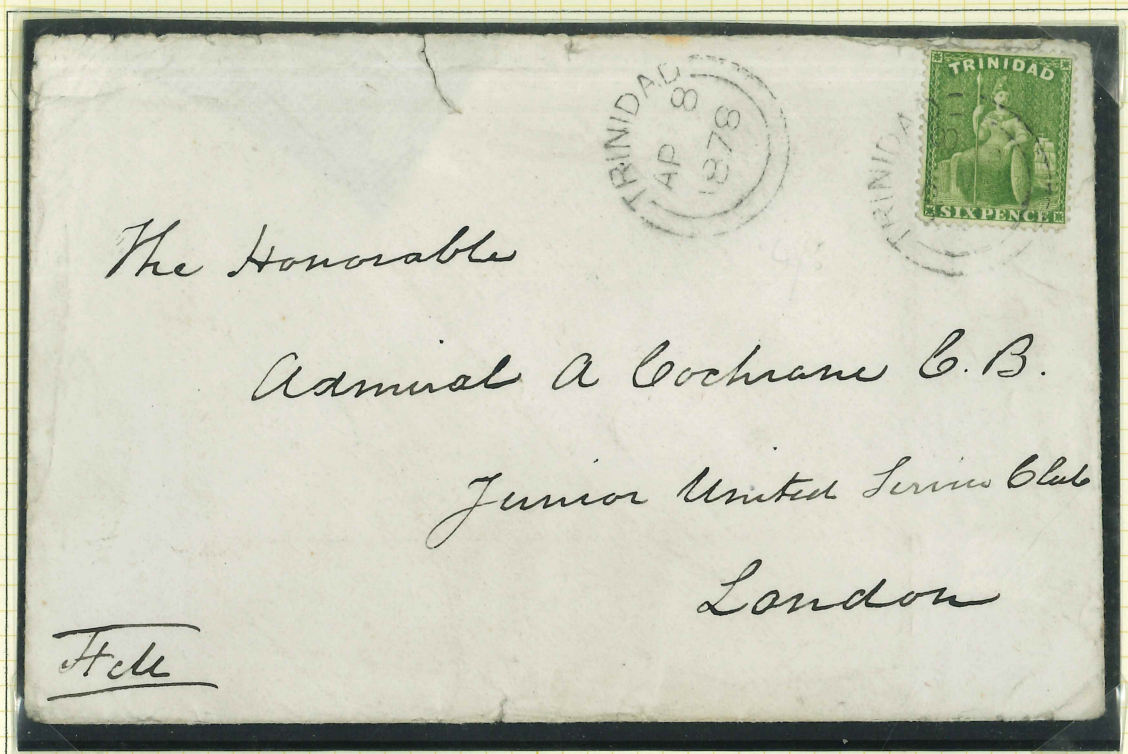

8 April 1878 - Cover to London addressed to Admiral Arthur Cochrane; the admiral had been on **HMS REPULSE** as Commander-in-Chief, the Pacific Station until 1873. In retirement he was involved in managing the Trinidad Lake Asphalt Company.

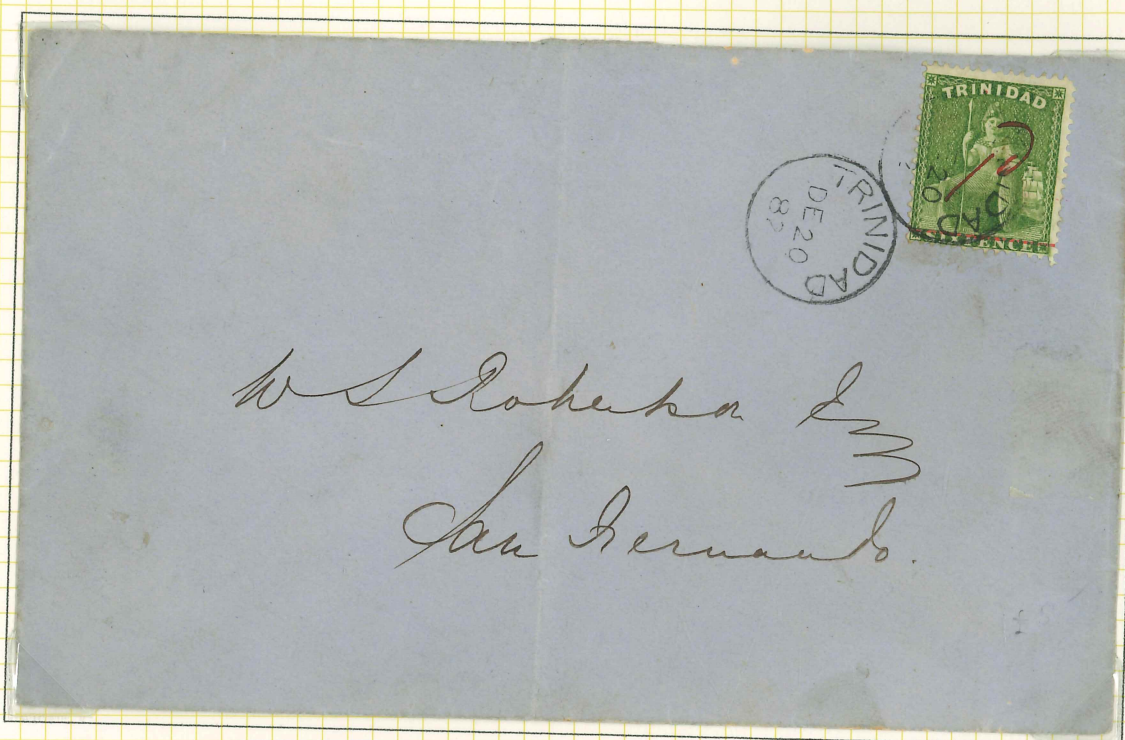

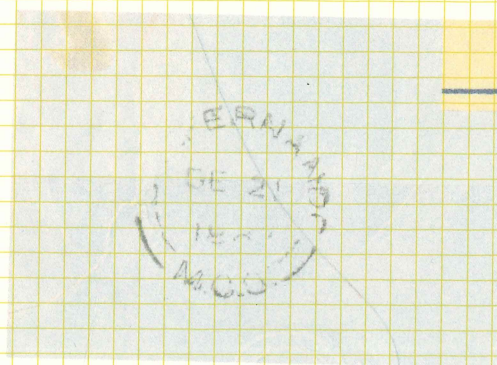

Mourning cover bearing four 1d on 6d yellow-green stamps addressed to Gloucester, England where it arrived on 13 November. These surcharged stamps were introduced on 9 May 1882 and were withdrawn from sale on 30 December of that year.
