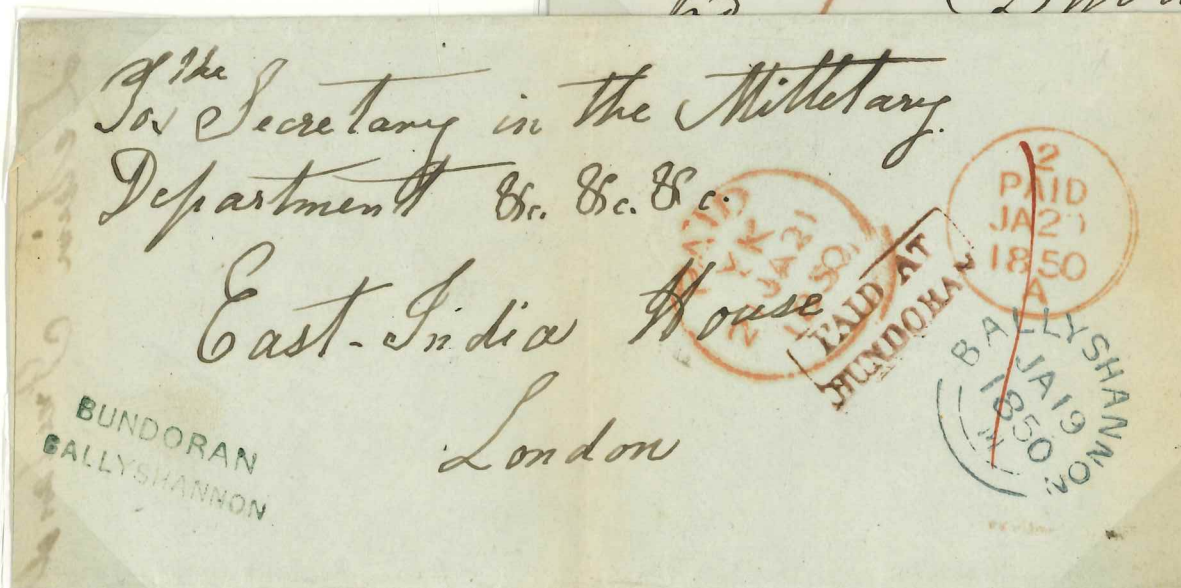
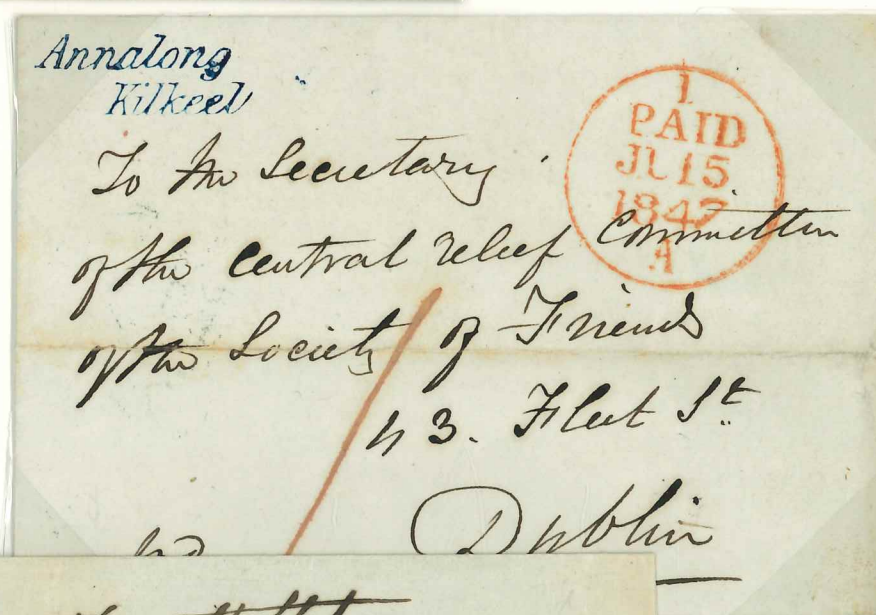
**1845 Shangolden Receiver**  
**1847/50 Annalong/Bundoran Receiver**

Twenty different types of *undated namestamps* (receivers) were used in Ireland by Sub Offices to record they had received the letter.



1845 (October 29<sup>th</sup>) letter from Shanagolden to Dublin showing a black single line unframed **SHANAGOLDEN** receiver, a **LIMERICK / OC30 / 1845 / E** datestamp. **PAID/OC31A/D45**, of Dublin rated **1** and endorsed **Paid**.

1847 (June 14<sup>th</sup>) letter from Annalong to Dublin showing a two line italic unframed **Annalong / Kilkeel** receiver, circular datestamp of Dublin **1/PAID/Ju15/1847/A** and rated **1 pd.**



1850 (January 19<sup>th</sup>) letter Ballyshannon to London showing a **BALLYSHANNON/JA1 9/1850/**, in blue, a two line sans serif blue **BUNDORAN** receiver, **PAID AT/BUNDORAN**, manuscript **1** in red and Dublin and London circular dated **PAIDS**.
