## 1845 Shangolden Receiver 1847/50 Annalong/Bundoran Receiver

Twenty different types of *undated namestamps* (receivers) were used in Ireland by Sub Offices to record they had received the letter.

1847 (June 14<sup>th</sup>) letter from Annalong to Dublin showing a two line italic unframed *Annalong / Kilkeel* receiver, circular datestamp of Dublin 1/PAID/Ju15/1847/A and rated 1 pd.
