

.An outer cover sent from Poona, a town South of Bombay, on the 23rd December 1857, and with two, four Anna stamps, cut to shape, addressed to Glasgow. The letter passed through Bombay on the 24th December with, on the reverse side, the **BOMBAY** (HG type X1) On the front of the letter is the handstamp "**INDIA PAID**" (HG type SD9) which indicated that postage had been paid both for Indian and U.K.Post. The cover arrived in London on 4th February 1858 and in Glasgow on the same day. Transit Time 42 days
