DOLLARD FEBRUARY 1922 PRINTING

Dollard set the overprint 15 times on a monotype machine, assembled the type into a Cliche 3 wide by 5 high and cast Stereos. 16 Stereos were assembled to make an overprint printing plate of 240 subjects.

Control numbers (R 21 Perforated through the
servedge), occur on British half penny & pence
values under stamp 2 row 20, except on the 1

All overprints are uniformly aligned.



NOTE:
'PLATE' refers to the
overprint printing plate.

Cliches may not be aligned with one another as may be
seen by the shift in the first 2 columns relative to the last 3.

Control number occurs on the 1 penny value under stamp 11.
