

**Postage Due  
Rate Numerals**

12 March 1863  
23 April 1875

Many styles of postage due numerals were introduced with Uniform Penny Postage. In the 1850s style with wavy line/two vertical bars under the denomination letter became standard across Ireland.

1s due of Dublin - unpaid packet letter.



1d due marking of Cork.

Letter from Dumdum, India, sent "via Brindisi", forwarded from Cork to Dublin. Additional backstamps: CALCUTTA/JUL 27 octagonal, and circular CALCUTTA/JUL 27/INDIA PAID.
