1921-34 Script wmk 3c, 6c, 8c, in matching lower right corner blocks of 4 with plate number '16', from 1927 printings, each showing the constant keyplate flaw 'colourless dot in thick frameline above E of POSTAGE' (R10/6) fine o.g. (lower pairs unmounted). An excellent trio, with only 358 sheets of the 8c printed from this plate.

1921-34 2c, 3c, 4c sage-green and carmine, die II, in matching lower left corner blocks of 4 with plate number '16', from March 1927 printing, and showing abnormal PERFORATIONS THROUGH LOWER MARGIN, o.g. 4c block with gum bends, still a very fine and most interesting trio, being a complete 'set' with this abnormal perforation, which is not otherwise known from any other keyplate (or colony!) in the entire KGV series in this design. Just these three values, in this printing, were perforated 60 set using a 'tete-beche' arrangement. (See Fernbank p.232).
