Cover from Turks Island to Halifax dated 14 January 1914 carried aboard the S.S. ANITA of the A Chandon line of New York. The ANITA was a small steamer built in 1895 of only 232 grt and 159 ft overall. An unusual cachet, this ship not regularly employed carrying mail.

NEW YORK PAQUEBOT

Cover to England with New York Paquebot duplex dated 6 February 1923. Two Id stamps cancelled with "498" barred oval obliterators (Liverpool) MANCHESTER. At this time the obliterator was not in general use but only on incoming mail where the stamps had not been cancelled previously.

NEW YORK PAQUEBOT.

Posted at New York and given a PAQUEBOT marking which is partly Hoskin type 957 and part type 956. There is an Index letter in a circle surrounded by ten bars in a vertical pval pattern. The index letter (N?) also appears at the top of the marking above the year, and was allocated daily to each consequtive arrival. Date is given as 1829!

Type 4 c.d.s. TURKS ISLANDS is inscribed at the top inside a double circle; Two heavy bars separated by a Maltese Cross at the bottom.

Index Letter A above the date.

Boxed slogan BUY/TURKS ISLANDS SALT/NONE BETTER used to cancel the stamps.

Backstamped: CASTRIES ST LUCIA
9 JA 33. (35 Days in transit!!)

Unsealed letter to England carried at the \$d rate.
