

WAR TAX.

During the GREAT WAR many Governments looking for ways of raising money to help pay for the War were not slow in raising a tax on letters. In some cases this meant raising the postal charges, in others the imposition of an additional fee.

Early in 1916 JAMAICA imposed a War Tax on mail and this measure was soon followed by other Islands.

War Tax stamps were issued by Turks and Caicos Islands from 1917 to 1919.

An additional charge of 1d was levied on ordinary letters and 3d for parcels and registered letters.

It was intended that postage would continue to be prepaid with normal stamps and the additional fee with the special Tax stamps. They are seldom found used in this way.

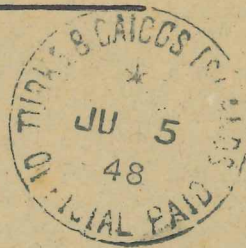

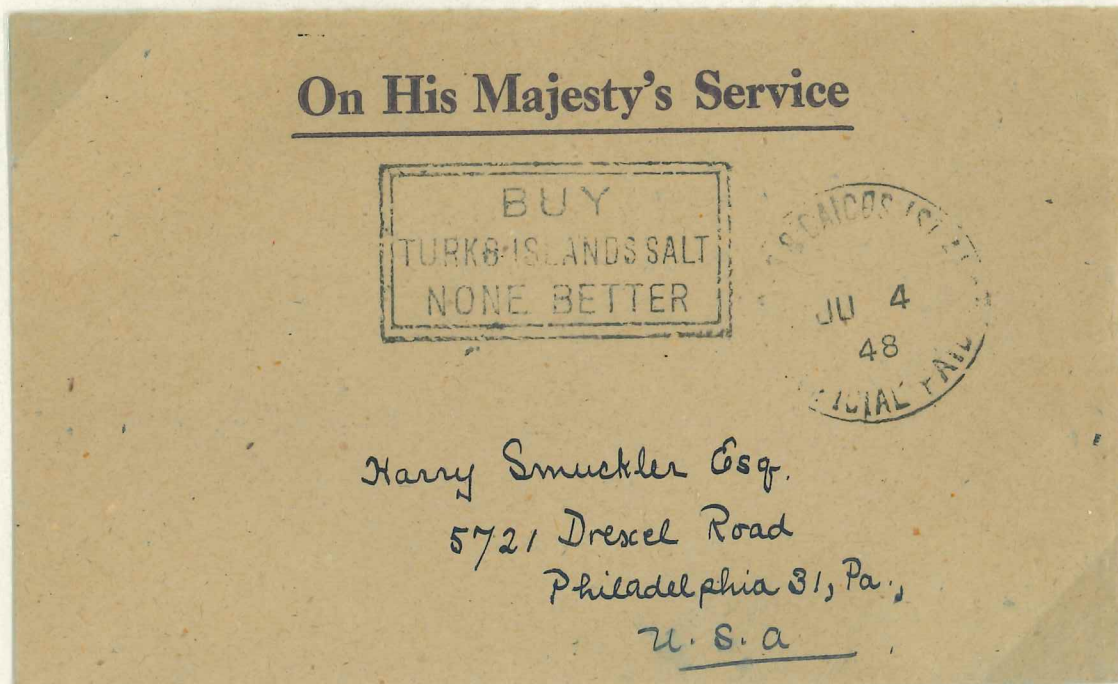
