The final version of this stamp had modified portraits and a different protrait of Corvin. It became the 1 leu purple design of the Anniversary set.

1 Leu - Carmine, blue, brown, lilac, green and violet, imperforate on white carton paper

This design was not adopted for this anniversary set.

First use of Horia, Closca and Crisan occurred in 1935 but with a different design

2 Lei – Green-blue, brown, carmine, violet, blue, lilac-brown, imperforate on off-white carton paper ungummed
2 male figures in traditional dress pushing together the coat of arms, with the date 1918-1928 below
This design was not adopted for this anniversary set.













Essay

- 3 Lei Carmine, blackish-green, yellow-green, violet, blue and brown, imperforate on white smooth paper ungummed
- 2 female figures in traditional dress holding coats of arms. With angel guiding figure on right. Angel has wings extending to top corner of stamps



The final version of this stamp had the 2 female figures holding one coat of arms and the angel with smaller wings. It became the 2 lei green design of the Anniversary set.
