1d red Lancashire, England, tied CORK 26 FE 23 c.d.s.

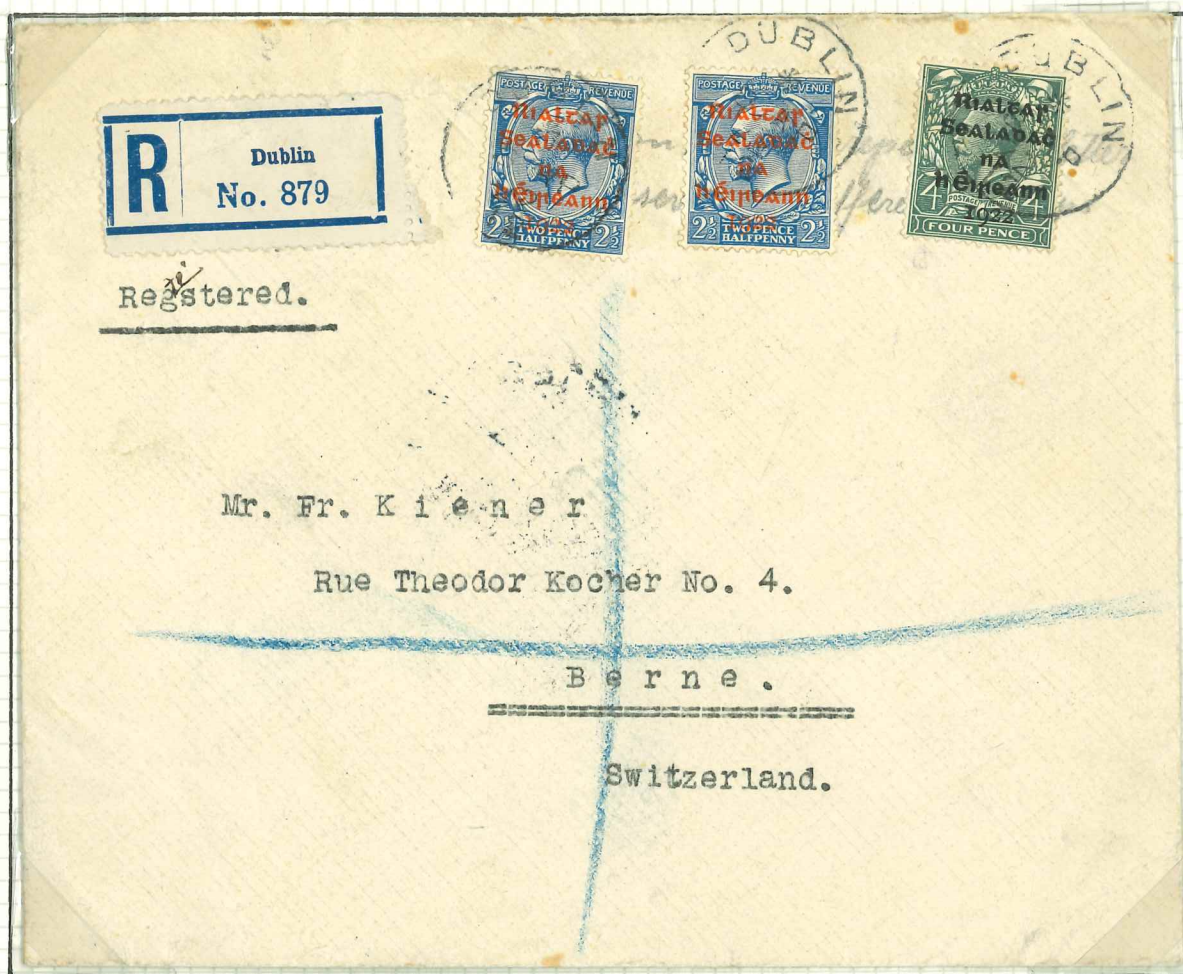

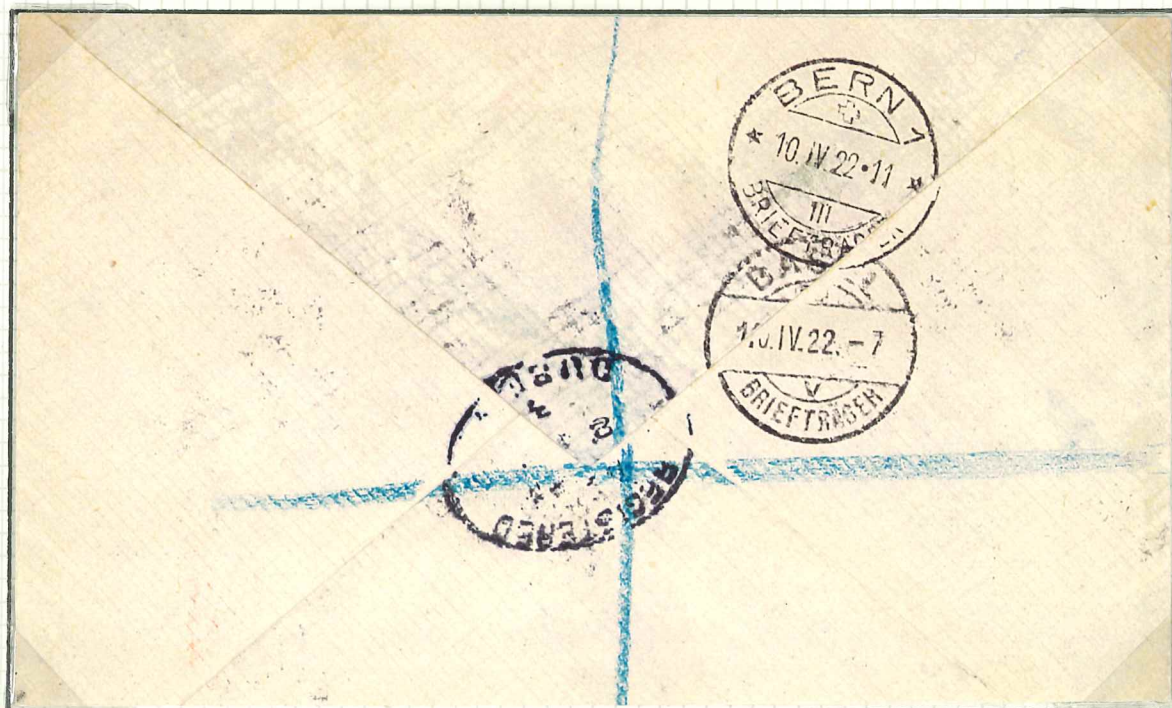
Dollard 5-line overprint in red.

Single blue 2½d., used, paying 2d. postage plus ½d. LATE FEE on cover to Hertford, England tied "H&K PACKET" / 8 PM 14. DE. 22 c.d.s., being posted on board the mail boat.

Dublin to Berne dated 8.AP.22 with 2½d overprinted in red and 4d black overprint. The red overprint was introduced 1. April 1922



Backstamped DUBLIN 8.AP.22. BASEL 10.IV.22 and BERNE 10.IV.22 on arrival.

Single 9d., agate used on registered cover Cork to London in June 1922. Over subscribed as 5d., was the registered letter rate to England at the time.
