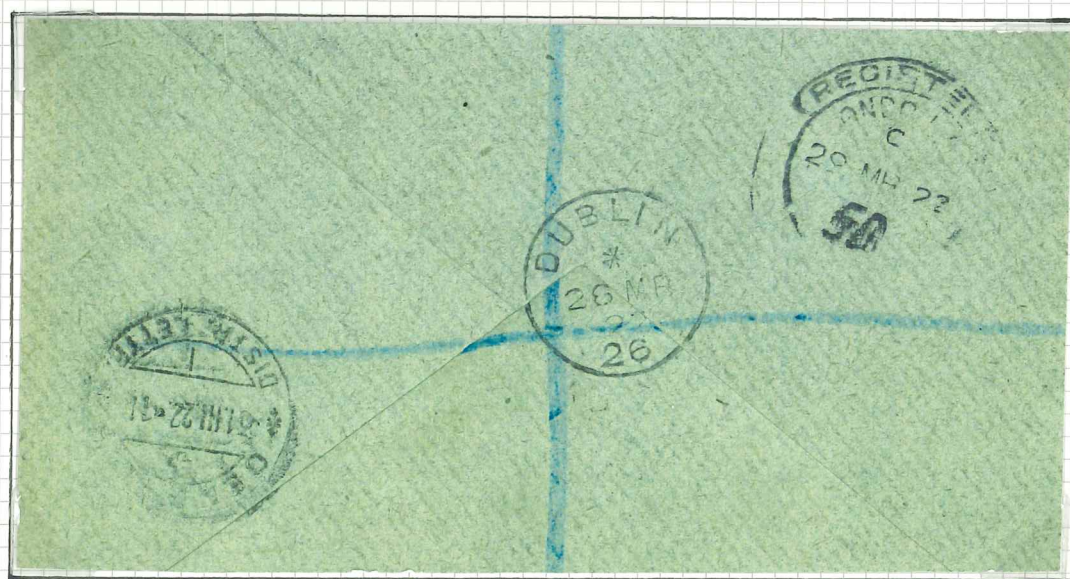


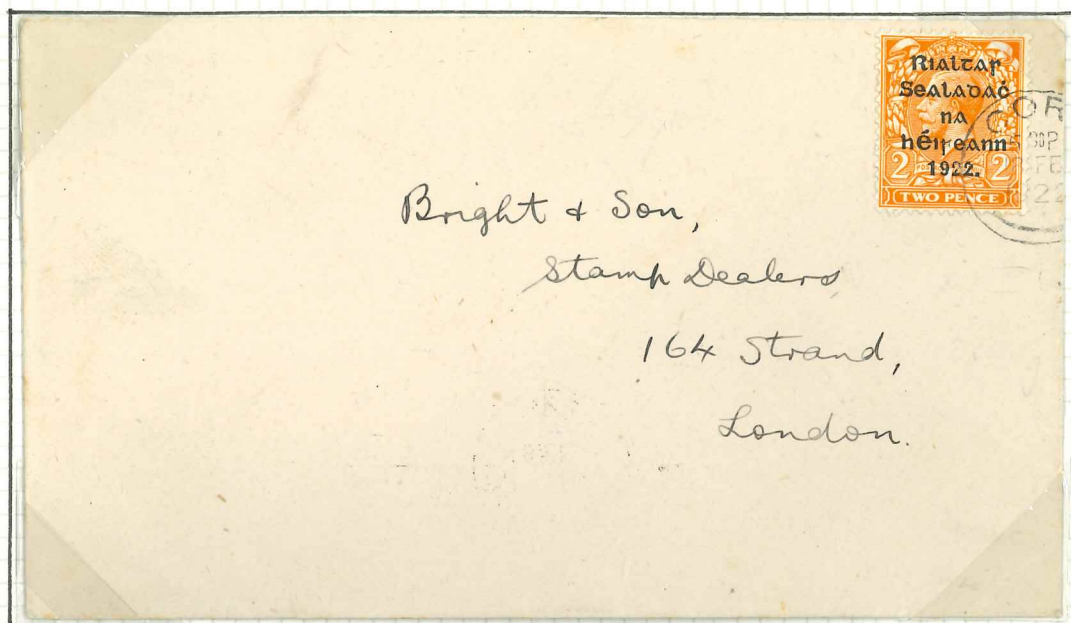

Backstamped DUBLIN - LONDON - GENEVA.

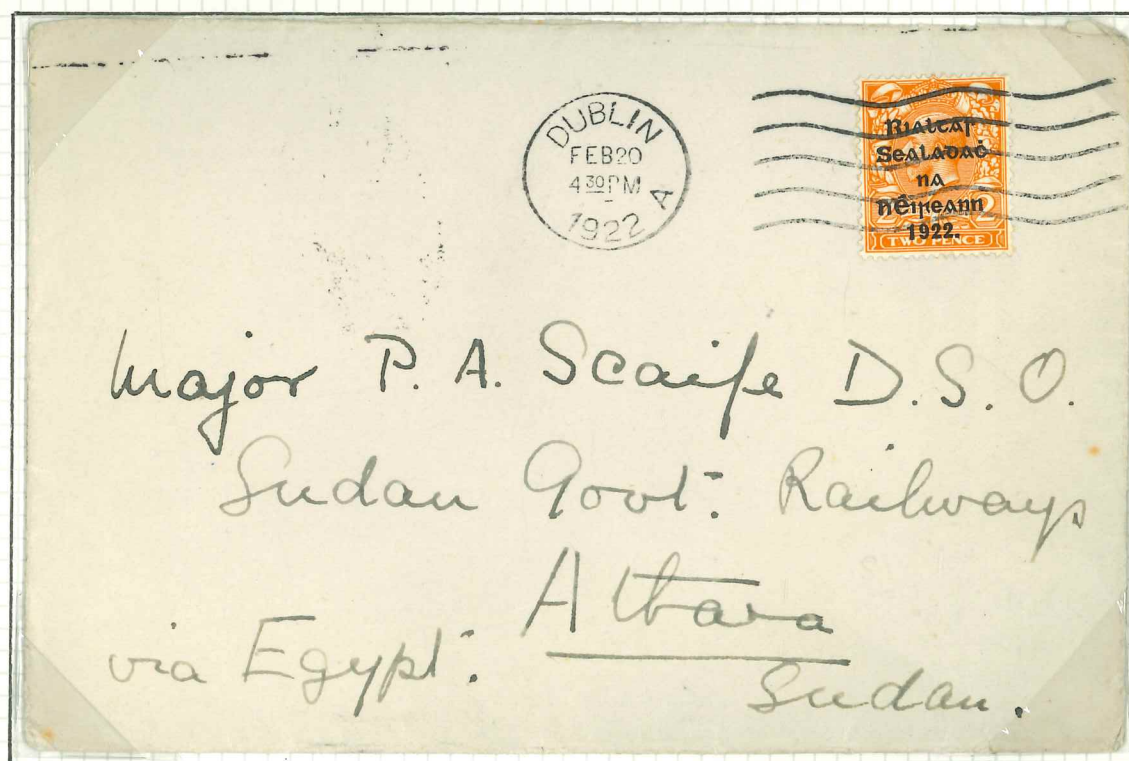

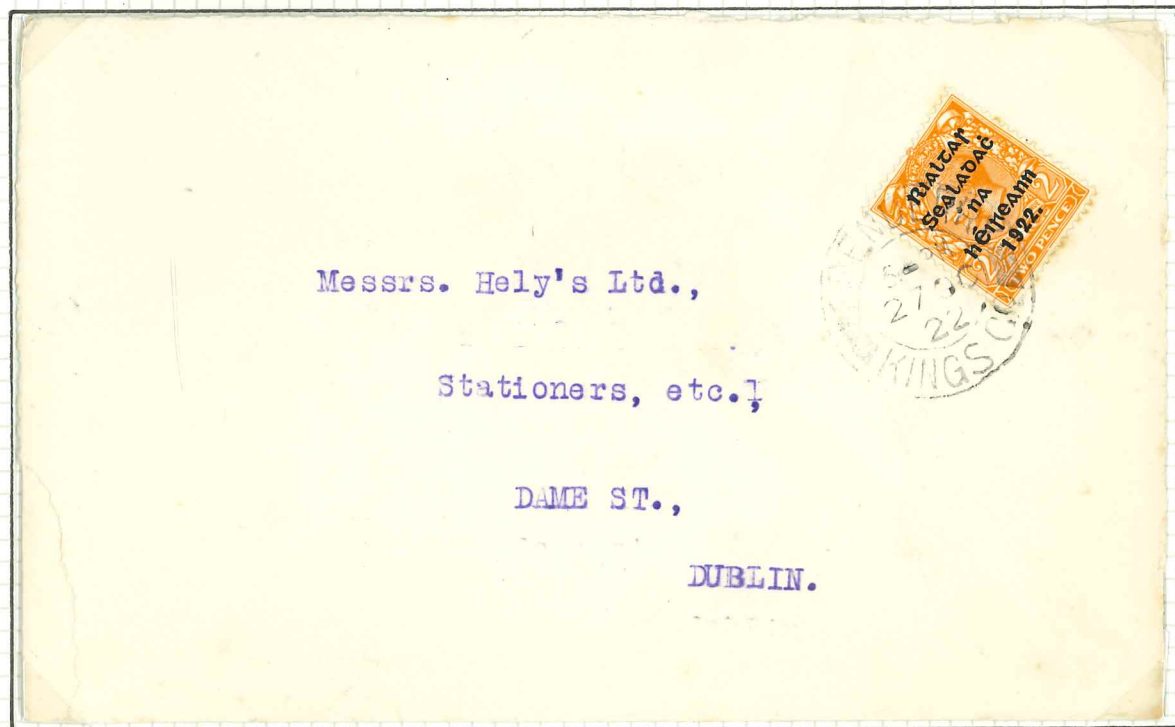

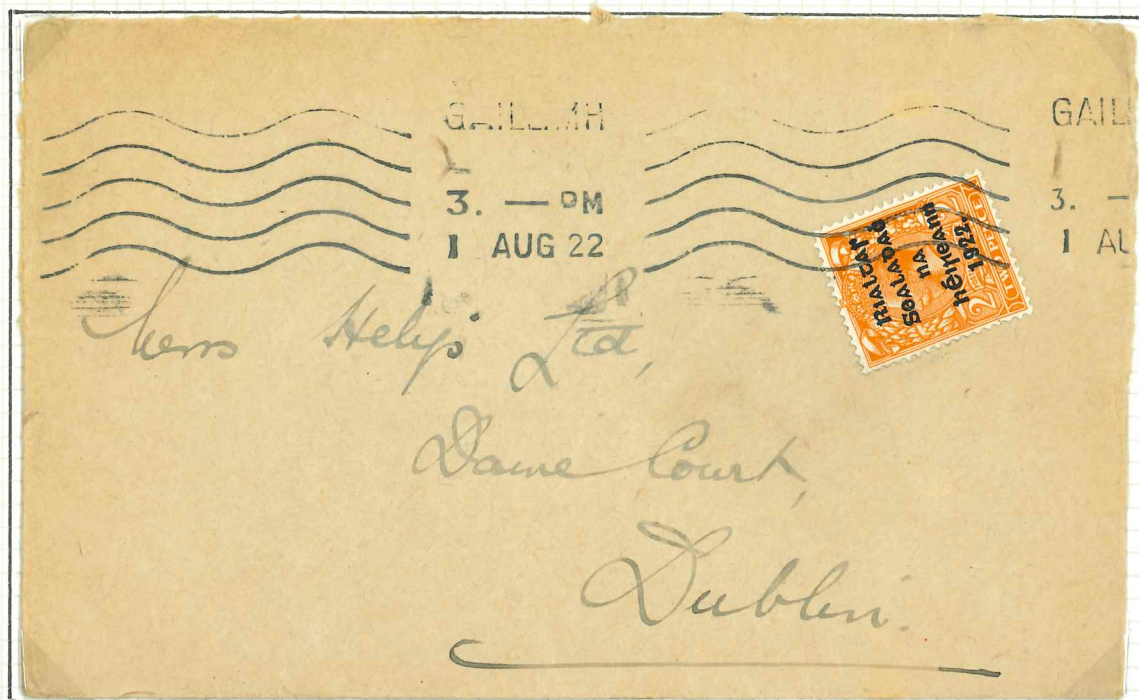


Post-marked "NEWBRIDGE IRELAND 4 APRIL 1922"

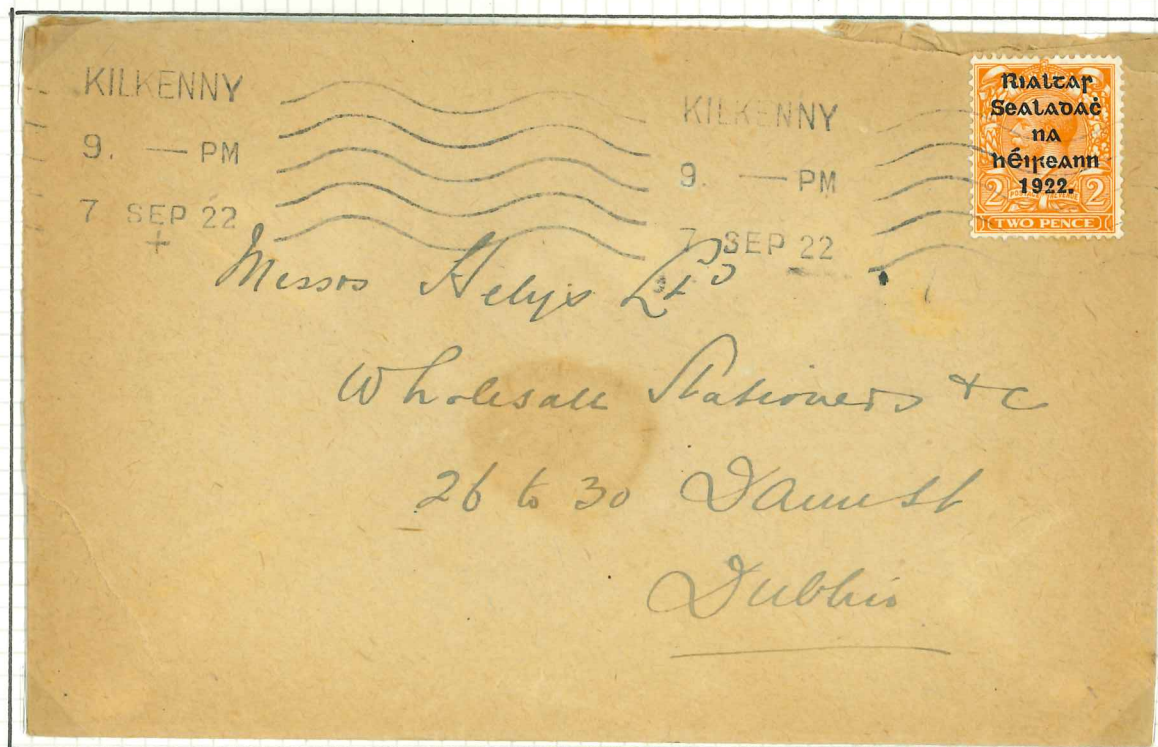

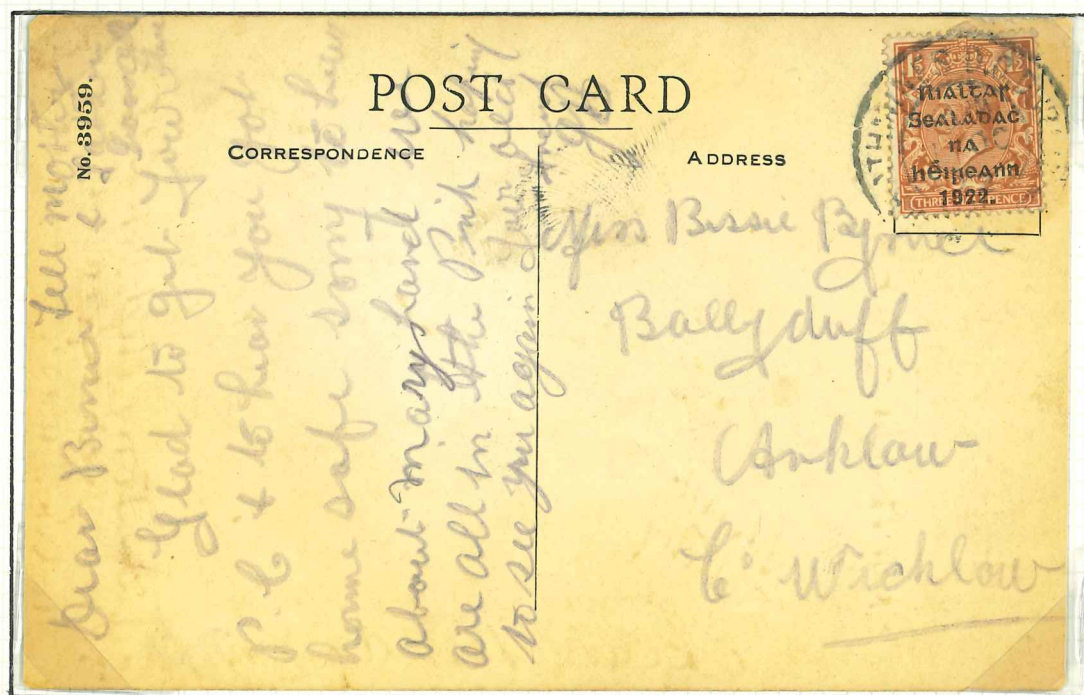
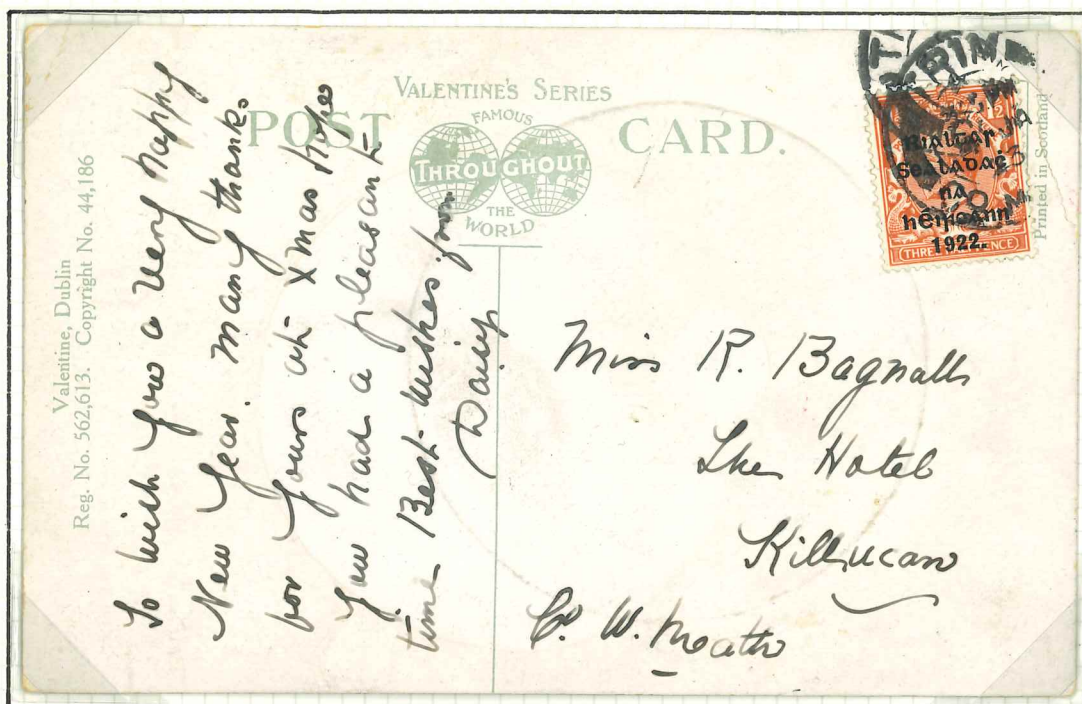


Krag Machine cancel. Galway 1. Aug 22.
