

OVERPRINT VARIETIES

The Government Printing House followed by Somerset House used a setting made up of 20 clichés, arranged in five rows of four, each row being separated from the next by the space of one stamp row. To overprint a full pane of forty stamps, two press passes were required. The first press pass overprinting stamps in rows 2,4,6,8 and 10 and the second pass stamps in alternate rows 1,3,5, 7 and 9.














OVERPRINT ERRORS

1925 August 3 - Line Overprint - 'Narrow' date

One sheet of 40 showing alternative horizontal rows of overprint double, one inverted is recorded.

From the example below the Bradbury printer's plate for the basic stamp was 2/7, as the stamps display the perfect 'S' in 'POSTAGE'.

The overprint plate used for printing the 'Narrow' date high values consisted of a setting of twenty clichés. Rows 1,3,5,7 and 9 were printed in the first operation and the sheets were then passed through the printing press a second time to overprint Rows 2,4,6,8 and 10.

In the case of the double overprint sheet, the sheet was passed through the press a third time, but the wrong way round. The result being a double inverted overprint on even rows.

As a result twenty such double overprints were produced.

The status of this error is considered dubious (ie - whether overprinted in error or deliberately?)

The Runnal's re-entry is the most important error to be found with the Dublin Castle Narrow overprints. The error is to be found on the 10/- value, from a perfect 'S' plate. Philatelic plate 2A (Bradbury Printer's plate 2/7L). Error occurs in position R6/1.

The re-entries are pronounced and especially apparent in Brittania's shield and its surround, as well as the doubling of virtually all the horizontal lines in the upper right portion of the stamp. Thus far only six examples have been recorded, one of which is used.
