Dollard 1/2d green used on German Empire 10 Pf reply card, answer half, tied Chapelized Dublin c.d.s. dated Ju. 22. 22. and sent to Berlin, hence re-directed to Danzig.



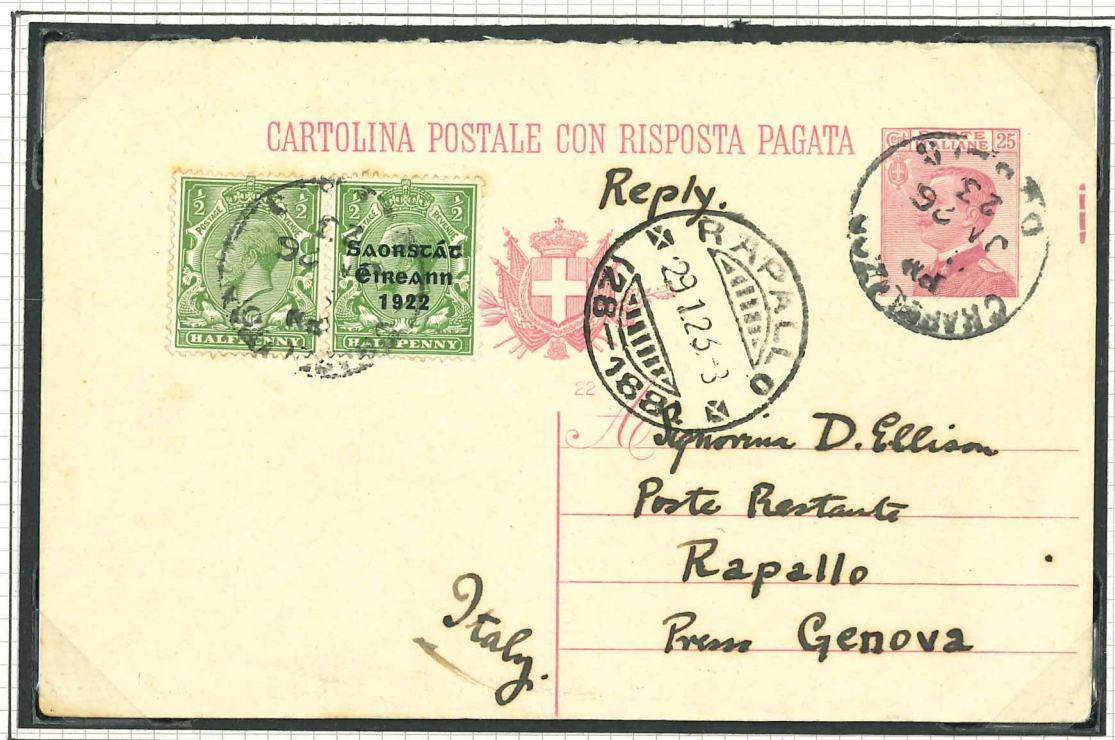
Dollard 1/2d green together with unoverprinted G.B. 1/2d on German Empire 5 Pf reply card, (reply half) cancelled Chapelized Dublin c.d.s. dated Ju. 22. 22. Redirected as above card to Danzig.

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Id red "Saorstát" on reply half of French 10c reply card to France, tied DUBLIN c.d.s. dated 8. JA. 23.



G.B. Id red with Thom 5-line overprint on French 10c reply card. Tied DUBLIN c.d.s., Dated 8. JA. 23.

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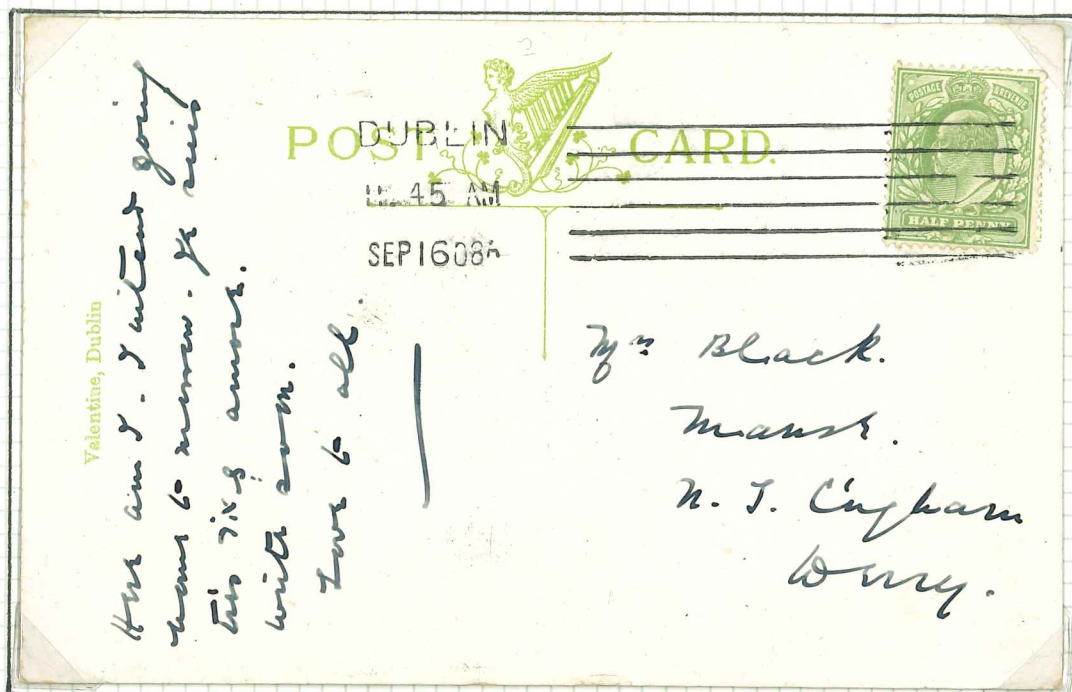
1/2d green overprinted "SAORSTÁT" used with unoverprinted
 1/2d Geo V green together on Italian 25 cent reply half of
 reply card. to Genoa, Italy.
 Tied CHAPELIZOD, DUBLIN c.d.s. dated JA.26.23.
 Arrival mark. RAPALLO dated 29.1.23.

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Two covers from Dublin to Berlin cancelled James Street D.O. Dublin and dated both 23 DE. 22.

Presumably to safeguard at incutting surcharges the sender of the reply half of the card added stamps to make up what was considered the foreign postcard rate.
