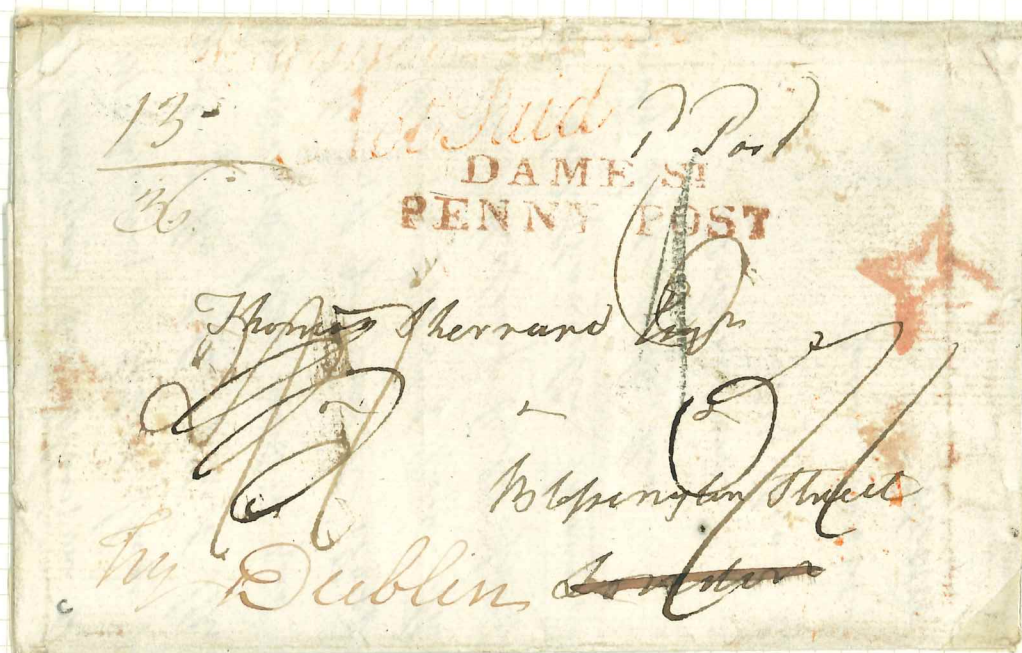

The Red Star indicates - "Posted out of course."

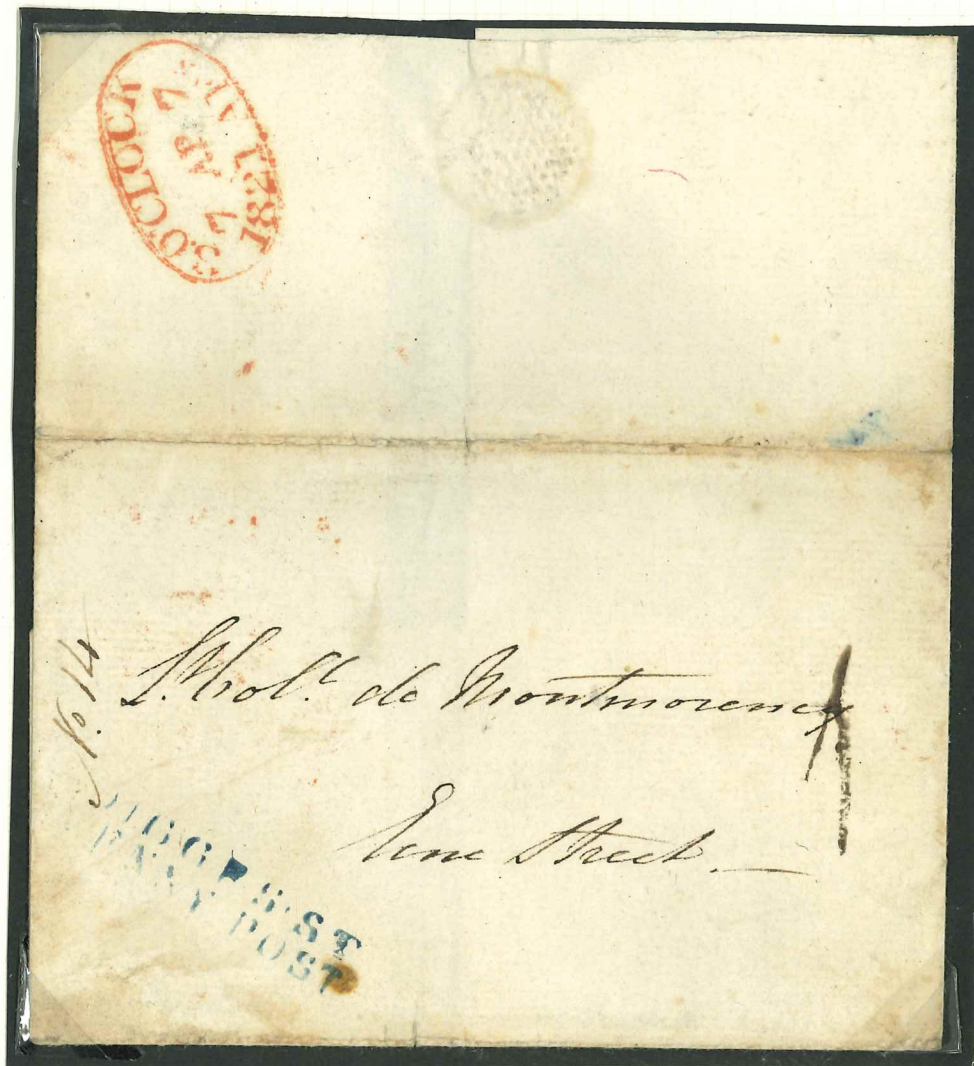
